- 3 29-4201 It is the intent and purpose of sections 29-4201
- 4 to 29-4207 to authorize the usage of audiovisual court appearances
- 5 and certain district court arraignments by writing written waivers
- 6 and pleas in criminal proceedings consistent with the statutory and
- 7 constitutional rights guaranteed by the Constitution of the United
- 8 States and the Constitution of Nebraska.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 29-4206, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 10 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 11 29-4206 The <u>county courts and</u> district courts may accept
- 12 <u>a written waiver of preliminary hearing and a written waiver of</u>
- 13 arraignment and plea of not guilty from any defendant. The forms
- 14 shall contain the necessary consent and waiver of the right to a
- 15 physical appearance, shall be signed by the defendant and his or her
- 16 counsel of record, if any, and shall be filed with the clerk of the
- 17 court. A defendant's use of written forms under this section shall
- 18 not prevent his or her right to all other process, procedures, and
- 19 <u>defenses allowed by state and federal law.</u>
