5	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 71-432, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
amended to read:

71-432 (1) A health care facility or health care service shall not 3 be established, operated, or maintained in this state without first 4 obtaining a license issued by the department under the Health Care 5 Facility Licensure Act. No facility or service shall hold itself out as a 6 7 health care facility or health care service or as providing health care services unless licensed under the act. The department shall issue a 8 9 license to health care facilities and health care services that satisfy 10 the requirements for licensure under the act.

(2) Any health care facility or health care service that is
operating a program of all-inclusive care for the elderly, as provided in
42 U.S.C. 1395eee, as such section existed on January 1, 2020, is exempt
from the provisions of the Health Care Facility Licensure Act relating to
operation of the program.
