- 5 Sec. 3. Section 60-3,130.04, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 60-3,130.04 (1) An owner of a historical vehicle eligible for
- 8 registration under section 60-3,130 may use a license plate or plates
- 9 designed by this state in the year corresponding to the model year when
- 10 the vehicle was manufactured in lieu of the plates designed pursuant to
- 11 section 60-3,130.03 subject to the approval of the department. The
- 12 department shall inspect the plate or plates and may approve the plate or
- 13 plates if it is determined that the model-year license plate or plates
- 14 are legible and serviceable and that the license plate numbers do not
- 15 conflict with or duplicate other numbers assigned and in use. An
- 16 original-issued license plate or plates that have been restored to
- 17 original condition may be used when approved by the department.
- 18 (2) The department may consult with a recognized car club in
- 19 determining whether the year of the license plate or plates to be used
- 20 corresponds to the model year when the vehicle was manufactured.
- 21 (3) If only one license plate is used on the vehicle, the license
- 22 plate shall be placed on the rear of the vehicle. The owner of a
- 23 historical vehicle may use only one plate on the vehicle even for years
- 24 in which two license plates were issued for vehicles in general.
- 25 (4) License plates used pursuant to this section corresponding to
- 26 the year of manufacture of the vehicle shall not be personalized message
- 27 license plates, Pearl Harbor license plates, prisoner-of-war license
- 28 plates, disabled veteran license plates, Purple Heart license plates,
- 29 amateur radio station license plates, Nebraska Cornhusker Spirit Plates,
- 30 handicapped or disabled person license plates, specialty license plates,
- 31 special interest motor vehicle license plates, Military Honor Plates, or

- 1 Nebraska 150 Sesquicentennial Plates, or Breast Cancer Awareness Plates.
- 2 Sec. 4. (1) The department shall design license plates to be known
- 3 as Breast Cancer Awareness Plates. The design shall include a pink ribbon
- 4 and the words "early detection saves lives" along the bottom of the
- 5 plate.
- 6 (2) The design shall be selected on the basis of limiting the
- 7 manufacturing cost of each plate to an amount less than or equal to the
- 8 amount charged for license plates pursuant to section 60-3,102. The
- 9 department shall make applications available for this type of plate when
- 10 it is designed.
- 11 (3) One type of plate under this section shall be alphanumeric
- 12 plates. The department shall:
- 13 (a) Assign a designation up to five characters; and
- 14 (b) Not use a county designation.
- 15 (4) One type of plate under this section shall be personalized
- 16 message plates. Such plates shall be issued subject to the same
- 17 conditions specified for personalized message license plates in section
- 18 60-3,118.
- 19 Sec. 5. (1) Beginning January 1, 2017, a person may apply to the
- 20 <u>department for Breast Cancer Awareness Plates in lieu of regular license</u>
- 21 plates on an application prescribed and provided by the department for
- 22 any motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer, except for a motor vehicle or
- 23 trailer registered under section 60-3,198. An applicant receiving a plate
- 24 under this section for a farm truck with a gross weight of over sixteen
- 25 tons shall affix the appropriate tonnage decal to the plate. The
- 26 <u>department shall make forms available for such applications through the</u>
- 27 county treasurers.
- 28 <u>(2) In addition to all other fees required for registration under</u>
- 29 the Motor Vehicle Registration Act, each application for initial issuance
- 30 or renewal of personalized message Breast Cancer Awareness Plates shall
- 31 be accompanied by a fee of forty dollars. No such additional fee shall be

- 1 due for the initial issuance or renewal of alphanumeric Breast Cancer
- 2 Awareness Plates. County treasurers collecting fees pursuant to this
- 3 subsection shall remit them to the State Treasurer. The State Treasurer
- 4 shall credit twenty-five percent of the fee to the Highway Trust Fund and
- 5 <u>seventy-five percent of the fee to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash</u>
- 6 Fund.
- 7 (3) When the department receives an application for Breast Cancer
- 8 Awareness Plates, the department shall deliver the plates to the county
- 9 treasurer of the county in which the motor vehicle or trailer is
- 10 registered. The county treasurer shall issue plates under this section in
- 11 <u>lieu of regular license plates when the applicant complies with the other</u>
- 12 provisions of the Motor Vehicle Registration Act for registration of the
- 13 motor vehicle or trailer. If Breast Cancer Awareness Plates are lost,
- 14 <u>stolen</u>, or mutilated, the licensee shall be issued replacement license
- 15 plates upon request pursuant to section 60-3,157.
- 16 (4) The owner of a motor vehicle or trailer bearing Breast Cancer
- 17 Awareness Plates may apply to the county treasurer to have such plates
- 18 transferred to a motor vehicle or trailer other than the motor vehicle or
- 19 <u>trailer for which such plates were originally purchased if such motor</u>
- 20 vehicle or trailer is owned by the owner of the plates. The owner may
- 21 have the unused portion of the fee for the plates credited to the other
- 22 motor vehicle or trailer which will bear the plates at the rate of eight
- 23 and one-third percent per month for each full month left in the
- 24 registration period. Application for such transfer shall be accompanied
- 25 by a fee of three dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection
- 26 <u>shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of</u>
- 27 Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
