## LEGISLATIVE BILL 846

## A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to labor; to require employers to maintain employee emergency contact information and notify them if the employee is injured.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) All employers shall maintain current
2	emergency contact information for each employee.
3	(2) Emergency contact information shall include:
4	(a) The current telephone number of the employee's spouse
5	or next of kin designated by the employee as his or her primary
б	emergency contact person; and
7	(b) The current telephone number of another person
8	designated by the employee as his or her secondary emergency contact
9	person.
10	(3) Whenever an employee is injured on the job and the
11	injury requires treatment at a medical facility, the employer or an
12	employer's representative shall make a reasonable effort to contact
13	the employee's primary emergency contact person to notify him or her
14	of the injury to the employee immediately after calling 911 emergency
15	service or while en route to a medical facility if 911 emergency
16	service was not called.
17	(4) If the employer or employer's representative is
18	unable to contact the primary emergency contact person, the employer
19	or employer's representative shall then make a reasonable effort to
20	contact the employee's secondary emergency contact person to notify
21	him or her of the injury to the employee.
