- 3 homestead exemption for certain disabled veterans as prescribed; to
- 4 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 77-3508, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 77-3508 (1)(a) All homesteads in this state shall be assessed for
- 4 taxation the same as other property, except that: there shall be exempt
- 5 from taxation, on any homestead described in subdivision (b) of this
- 6 subsection, a percentage of the exempt amount as limited by section
- 7 77-3506.03. The exemption shall be based on the household income of a
- 8 claimant pursuant to subsections (2) through (4) of this section.
- 9 (i) A homestead described in subdivision (b)(i), (ii), (iii), or
- 10 (iv) of this subsection shall receive an exemption from taxation which
- 11 <u>shall be equal to the exempt amount, as limited by section 77-3506.03,</u>
- 12 <u>multiplied by the applicable percentage from subsection (2) of this</u>
- 13 <u>section. Such percentage shall be based on the household income of the</u>
- 14 claimant; and
- 15 (ii) Beginning January 1, 2023, a homestead described in subdivision
- 16 (b)(v) of this subsection shall receive an exemption from taxation which
- 17 <u>shall be determined as follows:</u>
- 18 (A) The exempt amount, as limited by section 77-3506.03, shall be
- 19 multiplied by the applicable percentage from subsection (2) of this
- 20 <u>section. Such percentage shall be based on the household income of the</u>
- 21 <u>claimant; and</u>
- 22 (B) The amount determined under subdivision (a)(ii)(A) of this
- 23 <u>subsection shall then be multiplied by the applicable percentage from</u>
- 24 <u>subsection (3) of this section. Such percentage shall be based on the</u>
- 25 disability percentage of the claimant.
- 26 (b) The exemption described in subdivision (a) of this subsection
- 27 shall apply to homesteads of:
- 28 (i) Veterans as defined in section 80-401.01 who were discharged or
- 29 otherwise separated with a characterization of honorable or general
- 30 (under honorable conditions) and who are totally disabled by a non-
- 31 service-connected accident or illness;

- 1 (ii) Individuals who have a permanent physical disability and have
- 2 lost all mobility so as to preclude locomotion without the use of a
- 3 mechanical aid or a prosthetic device as defined in section 77-2704.09;
- 4 (iii) Individuals who have undergone amputation of both arms above
- 5 the elbow or who have a permanent partial disability of both arms in
- 6 excess of seventy-five percent;—and
- 7 (iv) Beginning January 1, 2015, individuals who have a developmental
- 8 disability as defined in section 83-1205; and -
- 9 (v) Beginning January 1, 2023, veterans as defined in section
- 10 <u>80-401.01</u> who were discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 11 <u>characterization of honorable or general (under honorable conditions) and</u>
- 12 who are fifty percent or more disabled, but less than totally disabled,
- due to a non-service-connected accident or illness.
- 14 (c) Application for the exemption described in subdivision (a) of
- 15 this subsection shall include certification from a qualified medical
- 16 physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse for
- 17 subdivisions (b)(i) through (b)(iii) of this subsection, certification
- 18 from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs affirming that the
- 19 homeowner is totally disabled due to a_non-service-connected accident or
- 20 illness for subdivision (b)(i) of this subsection, $\frac{1}{2}$ certification from
- 21 the Department of Health and Human Services for subdivision (b)(iv) of
- 22 this subsection, or certification from the United States Department of
- 23 Veterans Affairs affirming that the homeowner is disabled due to a non-
- 24 <u>service-connected accident or illness and documenting the disability</u>
- 25 percentage for subdivision (b)(v) of this subsection. Such certification
- 26 from a qualified medical physician, physician assistant, or advanced
- 27 practice registered nurse or from the Department of Health and Human
- 28 Services shall be made on forms prescribed by the Department of Revenue.
- 29 If an individual described in subdivision (b) (b)(i), (ii), (iii), or
- 30 (iv) of this subsection is granted a homestead exemption pursuant to this
- 31 section for any year, such individual shall not be required to submit the

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1 certification required under this subdivision in succeeding years if no

2 change in medical condition has occurred, except that the county assessor

3 or the Tax Commissioner may request such certification to verify that no

4 change in medical condition has occurred.

(2)(a) (2) For 2014, for a married or closely related claimant as described in subsection (1) of this section, the percentage of the exempt amount to be used in calculating the exemption allowed under this section for which the claimant shall be eligible shall be the percentage in Column B which corresponds with the claimant's household income in Column A in the table found in this subdivision subsection.

(b) (3) For 2014, for a single claimant as described in subsection (1) of this section, the percentage of the exempt amount to be used in calculating the exemption allowed under this section for which the claimant shall be eligible shall be the percentage in Column B which corresponds with the claimant's household income in Column A in the table found in this <u>subdivision</u> subsection.

(c) (4) For exemption applications filed in calendar years 2015 15 through 2017, the income eligibility amounts in subdivisions (2)(a) and 16 (b) subsections (2) and (3) of this section shall be adjusted by the 17 percentage determined pursuant to the provisions of section 1(f) of the 18 19 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as it existed prior to December 22, 2017. For exemption applications filed in calendar year 2018 and each calendar 20 21 year thereafter, the income eligibility amounts in <u>subdivisions (2)(a)</u> 22 and (b) subsections (2) and (3) of this section shall be adjusted by the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers 23 24 published by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics from the twelve months ending on August 31, 2016, to the twelve months ending on August 25 31 of the year preceding the applicable calendar year. The income 26 eligibility amounts shall be adjusted for cumulative inflation since 27 28 2014. If any amount is not a multiple of one hundred dollars, the amount shall be rounded to the next lower multiple of one hundred dollars. 29

(3) For a claimant described in subdivision (1)(b)(v) of this section, the amount determined under subsection (2) of this section shall
