3 32-101 Sections 32-101 to 32-1551 <u>and section 2 of this act shall be</u>
4 known and may be cited as the Election Act.

5 Sec. 2. (1) Any election conducted pursuant to the Election Act shall be funded only by an appropriation from the federal government, the 6 State of Nebraska, a political subdivision, or a combination of such 7 sources. The Secretary of State, election commissioners, and county 8 clerks shall not solicit, accept, or use any grants or donations from any 9 private entity for preparing for, administering, or conducting an 10 election. 11 (2) This section does not prohibit (a) the acceptance of an in-kind 12

12 <u>(12) This section does not prohibit (d) the deceptuate of an in kind</u> 13 <u>contribution of food or beverages for election workers during the</u> 14 <u>administration of an election or (b) the actual use of a public or</u> 15 <u>private building, without charge or for a reduced fee, for the purposes</u> 16 <u>of conducting an election, including use as a polling place or for</u> 17 <u>election training purposes.</u>
