2	Development Act; to amend sections 18-2701 and 18-2703, Reissue
3	Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 18-2705, Revised Statutes
4	Supplement, 2015; to authorize economic development programs
5	involving the construction or rehabilitation of certain housing; to
6	define a term; to require certain information in proposed plans; to
7	harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

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1 Section 1. Section 18-2701, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 13 18-2705 (1) Economic development program means any project or
- 14 program utilizing funds derived from local sources of revenue for the
- 15 purpose of providing direct or indirect financial assistance to a
- 16 qualifying business or the payment of related costs and expenses or both,
- 17 without regard to whether that business is identified at the time the
- 18 project or program is initiated or is to be determined by specified means
- 19 at some time in the future.
- 20 (2) An economic development program may include, but shall not be
- 21 limited to, the following activities: Direct loans or grants to
- 22 qualifying businesses for fixed assets or working capital or both; loan
- 23 guarantees for qualifying businesses; grants for public works
- 24 improvements which are essential to the location or expansion of, or the
- 25 provision of new services by, a qualifying business; grants or loans to
- 26 qualifying businesses for job training; the purchase of real estate,
- 27 options for such purchases, and the renewal or extension of such options;
- 28 grants or loans to qualifying businesses to provide relocation incentives
- 29 for new residents; the issuance of bonds as provided for in the Local
- 30 Option Municipal Economic Development Act; and payments for salaries and
- 31 support of city staff to implement the economic development program or

- 1 the contracting of such to an outside entity.
- 2 (3) For cities of the first and second class and villages, an
- 3 economic development program may also include grants or loans for the
- 4 construction or rehabilitation for sale or lease of housing for persons
- 5 of low or moderate income.
- 6 (4) For cities of the first and second class and villages, an
- 7 economic development program may also include grants, loans, or funds for
- 8 rural infrastructure development as defined in section 66-2102.
- 9 <u>(5) For cities of the first and second class and villages, an</u>
- 10 economic development program may also include grants or loans for the
- 11 <u>construction or rehabilitation for sale or lease of housing as part of a</u>
- 12 <u>workforce housing plan.</u>
- 13 $(\underline{6} \ 5)$ An economic development program may be conducted jointly by
- 14 two or more cities after the approval of the program by the voters of
- 15 each participating city.
- 16 Sec. 4. <u>Workforce housing plan means a program to construct or</u>
- 17 rehabilitate single-family housing or market rate multi-family housing
- 18 which is designed to address a housing shortage that impairs the ability
- 19 of the city to attract new businesses or impairs the ability of existing
- 20 <u>businesses to recruit new employees.</u>
- 21 Sec. 5. If the proposed economic development program involves the
- 22 making of grants or loans for the construction or rehabilitation for sale
- 23 or lease of housing as part of a workforce housing plan, the proposed
- 24 <u>plan shall include:</u>
- 25 (1) An assessment of current housing stock in the city, including
- 26 <u>both single-family and market rate multi-family housing;</u>
- 27 (2) Whether the plan will also include housing for persons of low or
- 28 moderate income under section 18-2710.01;
- 29 (3) Such other factors, as determined by the city, which are
- 30 particularly relevant in assessing the conditions faced by existing
- 31 businesses in recruiting new employees; and

- 1 (4) Such other factors, as determined by the city, which are
- 2 particularly relevant in assessing the conditions faced by persons
- 3 <u>seeking new or rehabilitated housing in the city.</u>
- 4 Sec. 6. Original sections 18-2701 and 18-2703, Reissue Revised
- 5 Statutes of Nebraska, and section 18-2705, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 6 2015, are repealed.
