9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 28-1418, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 28-1418 Whoever, being a minor under the age of eighteen 4 years, shall smoke cigarettes or cigars, use vapor products, or use 5 tobacco in any form whatever, including products made or derived from б tobacco, in this state, shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor. Any 7 minor so charged with the violation of this section may be free from 8 prosecution when if he shall have furnished evidence or she furnishes 9 for the conviction of the person or persons selling or giving him or 10 <u>her</u> the cigarettes, <u>vapor products</u>, cigars, or tobacco. 11 Sec. 2. For purposes of sections 28-1418 to 28-1429 and 12 sections 2 and 4 of this act: 13 (1) Self-service display means a retail display that 14 contains a tobacco product and is located in an area openly 15 accessible to a retailer's customers and from which such customers 16 can readily access tobacco products without the assistance of a 17 salesperson. Self-service display does not include a display case 18 that holds tobacco products behind locked doors; 19 (2) Tobacco specialty store means a retail store that (a) 20 derives at least seventy-five percent of its revenue from tobacco 21 products and (b) does not permit minors to enter the premises unless 22 accompanied by a parent or legal guardian; and 23 (3) Vapor products means any noncombustible tobaccoderived product containing nicotine that employs a mechanical heating 24 element, battery, or circuit, regardless of shape or size, that can 25

1	be used to heat a nicotine solution contained in cartridges. Vapor	
2	products includes any vapor cartridge containing such nicotine	
3	solution, an electronic cigarette, an electronic cigar, an electronic	
4	cigarillo, and an electronic pipe. Vapor products does not include	
5	any product that is regulated by the United States Food and Drug	
б	Administration under subchapter V - Drugs and Devices, of the Federal	
7	Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. 351 to 360ddd-2, as such	
8	sections existed on January 1, 2014.	
9	Sec. 3. Section 28-1419, Reissue Revised Statutes of	
10	Nebraska, is amended to read:	
11	28-1419 Whoever shall sell, give, or furnish, in any way,	
12	any tobacco in any form whatever, including products made or derived	
13	<u>from tobacco, or any cigarettes, or cigarette paper, <u>or vapor</u></u>	
14	products, to any minor under eighteen years of age, shall be guilty	
15	of a Class III misdemeanor for each offense.	
16	Sec. 4. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this	
17	section and section 28-1429.02, it shall be unlawful to sell or	
18	distribute cigarettes, cigars, vapor products, or tobacco in any form	
19	whatever, including products made or derived from tobacco, through a	
20	self-service display. Any person violating this section shall be	
21	guilty of a Class III misdemeanor. In addition, upon conviction for a

form whatever, including products made or derived from tobacco, may 1 2 be sold or distributed in a self-service display that is located in a 3 tobacco specialty store or cigar bar as defined in section 53-103.08. 4 Sec. 5. Section 59-1523, Revised Statutes Cumulative 5 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read: б 59-1523 (1) The cigarette tax division of the Tax 7 Commissioner may, after notice and hearing, revoke or suspend for any 8 violation of section 59-1520 the license or licenses of any person licensed under sections 28-1418 28-1420 to 28-1429 or sections 9 77-2601 to 77-2622. 10 11 (2) Cigarettes that are acquired, held, owned, possessed, 12 transported, sold, or distributed in or imported into this state in

violation of section 59-1520 are declared to be contraband goods and are subject to seizure and forfeiture. Any cigarettes so seized and forfeited shall be destroyed. Such cigarettes shall be declared to be contraband goods whether the violation of section 59-1520 is knowing or otherwise.

Sec. 6. Original sections 28-1418 and 28-1419, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 59-1523, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, are repealed.
