- Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$500,000 from Federal Funds
- 2 for FY2021-22 to the Department of Health and Human Services for Health
- 3 Aid. The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds
- 4 allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State
- 5 Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 6 <u>2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.</u>
- 7 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2021-22
- 8 \$500,000 Federal Funds for state aid, which shall only be used for such
- 9 <u>purpose</u>.
- There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for
- 11 FY2021-22 \$500,000 Federal Funds for the Human Immunodeficiency Virus
- 12 (HIV) Surveillance and Prevention Programs for education on the benefits
- 13 of preexposure prophylaxis medication and for the costs of medication.
- 14 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 15 passed and approved according to law.
