1 Section 1. Section 39-1811, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 39-1811 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this
- 4 section:
- 5 <u>(a)</u> It shall be the duty of the landowners each landowner
- 6 in this state to mow all weeds that can be moved with the ordinary
- 7 farm mower to the middle of all public roads and drainage ditches
- 8 running along their the landowner's lands at least twice each year,
- 9 namely, before July 157 for the first time and sometime in August for
- 10 the second time; and -
- 11 (2) (b)(i) Whenever a landowner, referred to in
- 12 subsections (1) and (3) of this section, neglects to does not mow the
- 13 weeds as provided in this section, it shall be the duty of the county
- 14 board shall, on complaint of any resident of the county, to-cause the
- 15 <u>such</u> weeds to be moved or otherwise destroyed; and on neglected
- 16 portions of roads or ditches complained of.
- 17 (3) (ii) The county board shall cause to be ascertained
- 18 and recorded an accurate account of ascertain and record the cost of
- 19 mowing or destroying such weeds, as referred to in subsections (1)
- 20 and (2) of this section, in such places, specifying, in such
- 21 statement or account of costs, the description of the land abutting
- 22 upon each side of the highway where such weeds were mowed or
- 23 destroyed, and, if known, the name of the owner of such abutting
- 24 land. The board shall file such statement with the county clerk,
- 25 together with a description of the lands abutting on each side of the

1 road where such expenses were incurred, and the county board, at the

- 2 time of the annual tax levy made upon lands and property of the
- 3 county, may, if it desires, assess such cost upon such abutting land,
- 4 giving such landowner due notice of such proposed assessment and
- 5 reasonable opportunity to be heard concerning the proposed assessment
- 6 before the same is finally made.
- 7 (2)(a) The electors of any county may vote on the
- 8 question of requiring the county to mow the weeds in all drainage
- 9 ditches in such county. The question may be put on the ballot of any
- 10 statewide general election by resolution of the county board of
- 11 <u>commissioners or county board of supervisors or by petition as</u>
- 12 provided in sections 32-628 to 32-632.
- 13 (b) The electors of any county which has voted pursuant
- 14 to subdivision (a) of this subsection to require the county to mow
- 15 the weeds in all drainage ditches may vote on the question of
- 16 removing such mowing requirement. The question may be put on the
- 17 ballot of any statewide general election which is held two years or
- 18 longer after the date of the election at which the electors approved
- 19 such mowing requirement. The question may be put on such ballot by
- 20 resolution of the county board of commissioners or county board of
- 21 supervisors or by petition as provided in section 32-628 to 32-632.
