## Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Political Accountability and
- Disclosure Act; to amend sections 49-1425 and 49-14,103.01, Reissue
- 3 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to redefine immediate family; to
- 4 change and eliminate provisions related to an interest in contracts;
- 5 and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 49-1425, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 49-1425 Immediate family shall mean a child <u>of an individual</u>
- 4 residing in an individual's household, a spouse of an individual, or an
- 5 individual claimed by that individual or that individual's spouse as a
- 6 dependent for federal income tax purposes.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 49-14,103.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 8 is amended to read:
- 9 49-14,103.01 (1) For purposes of sections 49-14,103.01 to
- 10 49-14,103.06, unless the context otherwise requires, officer means (a) a
- 11 member of the board of directors of a natural resources district, (b) a
- 12 member of any board or commission of any county, school district, city,
- 13 or village which spends and administers its own funds, who is dealing
- 14 with a contract made by such board or commission, (c) any elected county,
- 15 school district, educational service unit, city, or village official, and
- 16 (d) a member of any board of directors or trustees of a hospital district
- 17 as provided by the Nebraska Local Hospital District Act or a county
- 18 hospital as provided by sections 23-3501 to 23-3519. Officer does not
- 19 mean volunteer firefighters or ambulance drivers with respect to their
- 20 duties as firefighters or ambulance drivers.
- 21 (2) Except as provided in section 49-1499.04 or 70-624.04, no
- 22 officer may have an interest in any contract to which his or her
- 23 governing body, or anyone for its benefit, is a party. The existence of
- 24 such an interest in any contract shall render the contract voidable by
- 25 decree of a court of competent jurisdiction as to any person who entered
- 26 into the contract or took assignment of such contract with actual
- 27 knowledge of the prohibited conflict.
- 28 (3) An action to have a contract declared void under this section
- 29 may be brought by the county attorney, the governing body, or any
- 30 resident within the jurisdiction of the governing body and shall be
- 31 brought within one year after the contract is signed or assigned. The

- 1 decree may provide for the reimbursement of any person for the reasonable
- 2 value of all money, goods, material, labor, or services furnished under
- 3 the contract, to the extent that the governing body has benefited
- 4 thereby.
- 5 (4) The prohibition in this section shall apply only when the
- 6 officer or his or her parent, spouse, or child (a) has a business
- 7 association as defined in section 49-1408 with the business involved in
- 8 the contract or (b) will receive a payment, direct pecuniary fee, or
- 9 commission as a result of the contract.
- 10 (5) The prohibition in this section does not apply if the contract
- is an agenda item approved at a board meeting and the interested officer:
- 12 (a) Makes a declaration on the record to the governing body
- 13 responsible for approving the contract regarding the nature and extent of
- 14 his or her interest prior to official consideration of the contract;
- 15 (b) Does not vote on the matters of granting the contract, making
- 16 payments pursuant to the contract, or accepting performance of work under
- 17 the contract, or similar matters relating to the contract, except that if
- 18 the number of members of the governing body declaring an interest in the
- 19 contract would prevent the body with all members present from securing a
- 20 quorum on the issue, then all members may vote on the matters; and
- 21 (c) Does not act for the governing body which is party to the
- 22 contract as to inspection or performance under the contract in which he
- 23 or she has an interest.
- 24 (6) An officer who (a) has no business association as defined in
- 25 section 49-1408 with the business involved in the contract or (b) will
- 26 not receive a direct pecuniary fee or commission as a result of the
- 27 contract shall not be deemed to have an interest within the meaning of
- 28 this section.
- 29 (6) (7) The receiving of deposits, cashing of checks, and buying and
- 30 selling of warrants and bonds of indebtedness of any such governing body
- 31 by a financial institution shall not be considered a contract for

- 1 purposes of this section. The ownership of less than five percent of the
- 2 outstanding shares of a corporation shall not constitute an interest
- 3 within the meaning of this section.
- 4 (7) (8) If an officer's parent, spouse, or child is an employee of
- 5 his or her governing body, the officer may vote on all issues of the
- 6 contract which are generally applicable to (a) all employees or (b) all
- 7 employees within a classification and do not single out his or her
- 8 parent, spouse, or child for special action.
- 9 (8) (9) Section 49-14,102 does not apply to contracts covered by
- 10 sections 49-14,103.01 to 49-14,103.06.
- 11 (9)(a) (10)(a) This section does not prohibit a director of a
- 12 natural resources district from acting as a participant in any of the
- 13 conservation or other general district programs which are available for
- 14 like participation to other residents and landowners of the district or
- 15 from granting, selling, or otherwise transferring to such district any
- 16 interest in real property necessary for the exercise of its powers and
- 17 authorities if the cost of acquisition thereof is equal to or less than
- 18 that established by a board of three credentialed real property
- 19 appraisers or by a court of competent jurisdiction in an eminent domain
- 20 proceeding.
- 21 (b) District payments to a director of a natural resources district
- 22 of the market value for real property owned by him or her and needed for
- 23 district projects, or for cost sharing for conservation work on such
- 24 director's land or land in which a director may have an interest, shall
- 25 not be deemed subject to this section.
