1	A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to offenses against animals; to prohibit
2	restraining animals in the event of certain natural or manmade
3	disasters or severe weather events as prescribed; and to provide a
4	penalty.
5	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>(1) No animal shall be restrained with a chain, rope,</u>
2	cord, tether, cable, or similar device and left unsheltered or unattended
3	in the event of a severe weather event or natural or manmade disaster
4	including, but not limited to, during a tornado warning issued for the
5	jurisdiction by the National Weather Service or after a mandatory or
6	voluntary evacuation order has been issued for the jurisdiction by a
7	government authority.
8	(2) For purposes of this section:
9	(a) Animal has the same meaning as in section 28-1008; and
10	<u>(b) Severe weather event means the existence of severe climatic</u>
11	<u>conditions creating rain, hail, sleet, snow, high winds, extremely high</u>
12	or low temperatures, or any combination thereof that would make restraint
13	of an animal as described in subsection (1) of this section unsafe.
14	<u>(3) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a Class I</u>
15	<u>misdemeanor.</u>
