Section 1. Section 30-3810, Reissue Revised Statutes of 1 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 30-3810 (UTC 110) (a) Whenever notice to qualified 4 beneficiaries of a trust is required under the Nebraska Uniform Trust 5 Code, the trustee must also give notice to any other beneficiary who 6 has sent the trustee a request for notice. (b) A charitable organization expressly designated to 7 receive distributions under the terms of a charitable trust has the 8 rights of a qualified beneficiary under the code if the charitable 9 10 organization, on the date the charitable organization's qualification is being determined: 11 12 (1) is a distributee or permissible distributee of trust 13 income or principal; 14 (2) would be a distributee or permissible distributee of trust income or principal upon the termination of the interests of 15 16 other distributees or permissible distributees then receiving or eligible to receive distributions; or 17 18 (3) would be a distributee or permissible distributee of 19 trust income or principal if the trust terminated on that date. 20 (c) A person appointed to enforce a trust created for the 21 care of an animal or another noncharitable purpose as provided in section 30-3834 or 30-3835 has the rights of a qualified beneficiary 22 23 under the code. 24 (d) The Attorney General has the rights of a qualified 25 beneficiary with respect to a charitable trust having its principal
