4	provisions secondary violations; to change penalties; to harmonize
5	provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

Section 1. Section 60-399, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 60-399 (1) Except as otherwise specifically provided, no person 4 shall operate or park or cause to be operated or parked a motor vehicle 5 or tow or park or cause to be towed or parked a trailer on the highways 6 unless such motor vehicle or trailer has displayed the proper number of 7 plates as required in the Motor Vehicle Registration Act.

8 (2) In each registration period in which new license plates are not 9 issued, previously issued license plates shall have affixed thereto the 10 validation decals issued pursuant to section 60-3,101. In all cases such license plates shall be securely fastened in an upright position to the 11 motor vehicle or trailer so as to prevent such plates from swinging and 12 at a minimum distance of twelve inches from the ground to the bottom of 13 the license plate. No person shall attach to or display on such motor 14 vehicle or trailer any (a) license plate or registration certificate 15 other than as assigned to it for the current registration period, (b) 16 17 fictitious or altered license plates or registration certificate, (c) license plates or registration certificate that has been canceled by the 18 department, or (c) (d) license plates lacking current validation decals. 19

(3) (2) All letters, numbers, printing, writing, and other
 identification marks upon such plates and certificate shall be kept clear
 and distinct and free from grease, dust, or other blurring matter, so
 that they shall be plainly visible at all times during daylight and under
 artificial light in the nighttime.

25 (4) No person shall attach to or display on a motor vehicle or 26 trailer described in subsection (1) of this section any (a) fictitious or 27 altered license plates or registration certificates, or (b) any license 28 plates or registration certificates assigned to another vehicle or 29 trailer.

30 (5) Enforcement of subsections (2) and (3) of this section by state
 31 or local law enforcement agencies shall be accomplished only as a

secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been cited or
 charged with a traffic violation or some other offense.

3 (6) A violation of subsection (2) or (3) of this section is a Class
4 IV misdemeanor.

5 Sec. 2. Section 60-3,164, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 6 amended to read:

60-3,164 (1) <u>A Any person shall not operate or park who operates or</u>
parks a motor vehicle or <u>tow or park who tows or parks</u> a trailer on any
highway <u>unless such</u> , which motor vehicle or trailer has not been
registered as required by section 60-362, shall be subject to the penalty
provided in section 60-3,170.

12 (2) <u>If the A person who parks a motor vehicle or tows a</u> trailer 13 <u>described in subsection (1) of this section on any highway, which motor</u> 14 <u>vehicle or trailer</u> has been properly registered in this state but such 15 registration has expired, <u>the person shall</u> not be in violation of this 16 section or section 60-362 or <u>subject to the penalty provided in section</u> 17 60-3,170, unless thirty days have passed from the expiration of the prior 18 registration.

19 (3) A violation of this section is a Class IV misdemeanor.
