1 Section 1. Section 68-901, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is

- 3 68-901 Sections 68-901 to 68-991 <u>and section 2 of this act</u> shall be
- 4 known and may be cited as the Medical Assistance Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. <u>(1) On or before January 1, 2019, the department shall</u>
- 6 submit an application for a waiver or an amendment to the medicaid state
- 7 plan to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services under
- 8 <u>section 1115 of the Social Security Act, as such section existed on</u>
- 9 January 1, 2018, to implement a demonstration project to allow a resident
- 10 <u>of the State of Nebraska to purchase health care coverage through the</u>
- 11 <u>medical assistance program as specified in this section.</u>
- 12 <u>(2) The demonstration project shall (a) make such coverage available</u>
- 13 for purchase to the extent allowed by the Social Security Act, as such
- 14 act existed on January 1, 2018, to any resident of the state who is not
- 15 otherwise eligible for the medical assistance program, (b) require an
- 16 annual premium for such coverage in an amount not to exceed one hundred
- 17 fifty percent of the median expenditure paid on behalf of a recipient of
- 18 benefits under the medical assistance program during the immediately
- 19 preceding fiscal year, (c) require that benefits provided to a purchaser
- 20 of such coverage under this section are the same as other recipients of
- 21 benefits under the medical assistance program, and (d) not use federal
- 22 funds for benefits provided to a purchaser of such coverage under this
- 23 <u>section</u>.
- 24 (3) The department shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations
- 25 as necessary to carry out this section. The department shall not use
- 26 federal funds for purposes of this section.
