Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to courts; to provide for an education and
- 2 training program on child abuse and custody determinations; and to
- 3 provide powers and duties for the State Court Administrator.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The State Court Administrator may develop and
- 2 implement an ongoing education and training program regarding child abuse
- 3 for judges and relevant court personnel. The education and training
- 4 program shall include all aspects of the maltreatment of children,
- 5 <u>including all of the following:</u>
- 6 <u>(a) Sexual abuse;</u>
- 7 (b) Physical abuse;
- 8 (c) Psychological and emotional abuse;
- 9 <u>(d) Implicit and explicit bias;</u>
- 10 <u>(e) Trauma and neglect; and</u>
- 11 (f) The impact of child abuse and domestic violence on children.
- 12 (2) The education and training program shall include the latest best
- 13 practices from evidence-based, peer-reviewed research by recognized
- 14 <u>experts</u>, including family violence experts, in the types of maltreatment
- 15 listed in subsection (1) of this section. The State Court Administrator
- 16 shall design the program to educate and train relevant court personnel on
- 17 all relevant factors relating to custody determinations and improve the
- 18 ability of courts to make appropriate custody decisions that are in the
- 19 best interest of the child, including education and training regarding
- 20 the impact of child abuse, domestic abuse, and trauma on a victim,
- 21 specifically a child, and situations when one party attempts to turn a
- 22 child against another party.
- 23 (3) The State Court Administrator shall design the education and
- 24 training program to conform with the requirements for increased federal
- 25 grant funding under 34 U.S.C. 10446(k).
