- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2018, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To amend Article I, section 22:
- 7 I-22 (1) All elections shall be free; and there shall be no
- 8 hindrance or impediment to the right of a qualified voter to exercise the
- 9 elective franchise.
- 10 (2) In order to protect the fundamental constitutional right of each
- 11 eligible citizen to vote, requiring a voter to present identification
- 12 prior to being able to vote shall be prohibited.
- 13 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 14 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 15 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 16 A constitutional amendment to prohibit requiring presentation of
- 17 identification prior to voting.
