LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 238

Introduced by Dubas, 34.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to study the service delivery system in Nebraska. The study shall examine the Access Nebraska system in general, as well as the separation of the economic assistance programs from the medicaid program, including application processes and data sharing. The study shall also examine the connection of these systems to the new health care marketplace.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

1. That the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
