PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Scheer, 19.

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND
2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2020, the following
4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

6 To amend Article III, section 6:

7 III-6 The Legislature shall consist of not more than fifty-five
8 ~~fifty~~ members and not less than thirty members. The sessions of the
9 Legislature shall be annual except as otherwise provided by this
10 constitution or as may be otherwise provided by law.

11 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
12 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
13 section 1, with the following ballot language:

14 A constitutional amendment to authorize an increase in the maximum
15 number of members of the Legislature not to exceed fifty-five members.
16 Any increase to the current number of forty-nine members will require an
17 act of the Legislature as provided by law.
