- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To amend Article VI, section 1:
- 7 VI-1 Only a Every citizen of the United States who has attained the
- 8 age of eighteen years on or before the first Tuesday after the first
- 9 Monday in November and has resided within the state and the county and
- 10 voting precinct for the terms provided by law shall, except as provided
- 11 in section 2 of this article, be an elector for the calendar year in
- 12 which such citizen has attained the age of eighteen years and for all
- 13 succeeding calendar years.
- 14 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 15 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 16 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 17 A constitutional amendment to change qualifications of electors.
