PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Linehan, 39.

- 1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST
- 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:
- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2024, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- To amend Article VII, section 3:
- 7 VII-3 The State Board of Education shall be composed of seven eight
- 8 members, who shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and
- 9 consent of the Legislature, with initial appointments of two members for
- 10 <u>a term of two years, two members for a term of four years, and three</u>
- 11 members for a term of six years. As the terms of the members expire, the
- 12 Governor shall appoint or reappoint a member for a term of six years to
- 13 succeed the member whose term expires elected from eight districts of
- 14 substantially equal population as provided by the Legislature. Their term
- 15 of office shall be for four years each. Their duties and powers shall be
- 16 prescribed by the Legislature, and they shall receive no compensation,
- 17 but shall be reimbursed their actual expense incurred in the performance
- 18 of their duties. The members of the State Board of Education shall not be
- 19 actively engaged in the educational profession—and they shall be elected
- 20 on a nonpartisan ballot.
- 21 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 22 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 23 section 1, with the following ballot language:

- 1 A constitutional amendment to change the composition of the State
- 2 Board of Education to seven members appointed by the Governor with the
- 3 advice and consent of the Legislature.
