with committee amendments

The Assembly Tourism, Gaming and the Arts Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 2813.

As amended by the committee, this bill requires the State Capitol Joint Management Commission to designate space in the State House or on the grounds of the State House for the display of art work from each county in New Jersey. Each county will have an opportunity to have art work displayed from their respective county, determined by a schedule to be established by the commission. Each display will be for at least 60 days and will include only art work from the scheduled county. The Director of Public Information, in the Office of Legislative Services, will select which art work will be displayed, based on the standards promulgated by the commission. The bill would take effect 180 days following the date of enactment.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

The committee amended the bill to change the effective date to 180 days following the date of enactment.

This change is to ensure that the bill does not interfere with the State House renovation project, which is scheduled to be completed in January of 2023.
