11 RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION; AMENDING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE  
12 TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM SALARY FOR CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT  
13 PERSONNEL.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 22-10A-39 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1994,  
17 Chapter 95, Section 1) is amended to read:

18 "22-10A-39. [~~NONCERTIFIED~~] CERTAIN SCHOOL PERSONNEL--  
19 SALARIES.--Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 50-4-22  
20 NMSA 1978, a [~~local~~] school district or a charter school shall  
21 pay a minimum wage rate of [~~six dollars (\$6.00)~~] fifteen  
22 dollars (\$15.00) per hour through fiscal year 2019 to all  
23 [~~noncertified school personnel~~] school district cafeteria staff  
24 and school bus drivers, whether under contract or employment;  
25 and all noncertified school personnel and licensed educational

1 assistants; provided that, beginning with fiscal year 2020 and  
2 in each subsequent fiscal year, that amount shall be adjusted  
3 by the percentage change between the penultimate calendar year  
4 and the immediately preceding calendar year of the consumer  
5 price index for the United States, all items, as published by  
6 the United States department of labor."

7 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the  
8 provisions of this act is July 1, 2017.
