16	SECTION 1. Section 10-9-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1961,

18	"10-9-15. DUTIES OF STATE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYERS
19	$\underline{A.}$ All officers and employers of the state shall
20	comply with the Personnel Act.
21	B. All employers shall:
22	(1) hire employees only from employment lists
23	of applicants who meet prescribed minimum requirements and have
24	passed the prescribed tests provided by the director; <u>and</u>
25	(2) require employees to be physically present

2	to that employment; provided that accommodations may be
3	provided:
4	(a) to comply with other applicable
5	federal law;
6	(b) if the duties related to that
7	employment require travel away from the place of employment;

10	(d) in the event private employers
11	reduce their in-person workforce by fifty percent or greater in
12	response to a public health emergency, as determined by the
