AN ACT

RELATING TO MISSING PERSONS; REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO SHARE CERTAIN INFORMATION WITH THE NATIONAL MISSING AND UNIDENTIFIED PERSONS SYSTEM CREATED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE'S NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF JUSTICE; NAMING THE REQUIREMENT THE "MARK DANIEL AGUILAR INFORMATION SHARING REQUIREMENT".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1.** A new section of the Missing Persons Information and Reporting Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY--MARK DANIEL AGUILAR INFORMATION SHARING REQUIREMENT.--

A. As soon as it is practicable, the department of public safety shall share with the national missing and unidentified persons system created by the United States

1 department of justice's national institute of justice:

2 (1) all information in the missing persons  
3 information clearinghouse; and

4 (2) all information the department receives  
5 pursuant to the Missing Persons Information and Reporting Act  
6 regarding the identification and location of missing and  
7 unidentified persons or human remains.

8 B. The requirements pursuant to this section shall  
9 be known as the "Mark Daniel Aguilar information sharing  
10 requirement".
