HOUSE BILL 219

52ND LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2016

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS; AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM CERTAIN FUNDS AND BALANCES; CLARIFYING CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS; ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF SEVERANCE TAX BOND PROCEEDS; ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts authorized for purposes specified in this act. The state board

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1 of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in
2 the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a
3 finding by the board that the project has been developed
4 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can
5 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board
6 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary
7 to comply with the federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as
8 amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated
9 for the purposes specified in this act.

10 B. The agencies named in this act shall certify to
11 the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of
12 the severance tax bonds appropriated in this section is needed
13 for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this
14 act. If an agency has not certified the need for severance tax
15 bond proceeds for a particular project by the end of fiscal
16 year 2018, the authorization for that project is void.

17 C. Before an agency may certify for the need of
18 severance tax bond proceeds, the project must be developed
19 sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

- 20 (1) incur within six months after the
21 applicable bond proceeds are available for the project a
22 substantial binding obligation to a third party to expend at
23 least five percent of the bond proceeds for the project; and
24 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of the
25 bond proceeds within three years after the applicable bond

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1 proceeds are available for the project.

2 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
3 law:

4 (1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
5 of severance tax bonds appropriated in this act for a project
6 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund no later than
7 the following dates:

8 (a) for a project for which severance
9 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to match federal grants,
10 six months after completion of the project;

11 (b) for a project for which severance
12 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to purchase vehicles,
13 including emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require
14 special equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational
15 technology; or other equipment or furniture that is not related
16 to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the
17 end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in
18 which the severance tax bond proceeds were made available for
19 the purchase; and

20 (c) for any other project for which
21 severance tax bonds were appropriated, within six months of
22 completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal
23 year 2020; and

24 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
25 of severance tax bonds appropriated for a project in this act

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1 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund three months
2 after the latest reversion date specified for that type of
3 project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

4 E. Except for appropriations to the capital program
5 fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided pursuant
6 to this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

7 F. Except for a project that was originally funded
8 using a tax-exempt loan or bond issue, a project involving
9 repayment of debt previously incurred shall be funded through
10 the issuance of taxable severance tax bonds with a term that
11 does not extend beyond the fiscal year in which they are
12 issued.

13 G. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
14 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
15 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
16 written obligations to third parties.

17 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
18 LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

19 A. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
20 law:

21 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
22 made in this act from the general fund or other state funds
23 shall revert no later than the following dates:

24 (a) for a project for which an
25 appropriation was made to match federal grants, six months

1 after completion of the project;

2 (b) for a project for which an
3 appropriation was made to purchase vehicles, including
4 emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require special
5 equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or
6 other equipment or furniture that is not related to a more
7 inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of the
8 fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the
9 appropriation was made for the purchase; and

10 (c) for any other project for which an
11 appropriation was made, within six months of completion of the
12 project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2020; and

13 (2) all remaining balances from an
14 appropriation made in this act for a project shall revert three
15 months after the latest reversion date specified for that type
16 of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

17 B. Except for appropriations to the capital program
18 fund, money from appropriations made in this act shall not be
19 used to pay indirect project costs.

20 C. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
21 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
22 fund shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
23 of this section to the capital projects fund.

24 D. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
25 section, the balance of an appropriation made from other state

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1 funds shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
2 of this section to the originating fund.

3 E. The balance of an appropriation made from the
4 general fund or other state funds to the Indian affairs
5 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
6 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
7 shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A of
8 this section to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

9 F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
10 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
11 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
12 written obligations to third parties.

13 SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT
14 ATTORNEYS PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the
15 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the
16 administrative office of the district attorneys that the need
17 exists for the issuance of the bonds, twenty thousand dollars
18 (\$20,000) is appropriated to the administrative office of the
19 district attorneys to purchase and install information
20 technology, including related equipment, furniture and
21 infrastructure, and to purchase and equip vehicles for district
22 attorney offices statewide.

23 SECTION 4. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT
24 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of
25 Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the aging and

1 long-term services department that the need exists for the
2 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
3 to the aging and long-term services department for the
4 following purposes:

- 5 1. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to plan,
6 design, construct and equip an addition to the Village of
7 Tijeras senior center in Tijeras in Bernalillo county;
- 8 2. eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to plan,
9 design, construct, equip, purchase and install improvements to
10 senior centers in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county;
- 11 3. one hundred eighteen thousand five hundred
12 dollars (\$118,500) to plan, design, construct, furnish and
13 equip a senior center in Wagon Mound in Mora county;
- 14 4. one hundred twenty-four thousand dollars
15 (\$124,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a
16 senior center in the Upper Fruitland chapter of the Navajo
17 Nation in San Juan county;
- 18 5. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for
19 improvements to the facility to address code compliance issues
20 at the Picuris senior center in the Pueblo of Picuris in Taos
21 county;
- 22 6. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan,
23 design and construct a senior center in the Red Rock chapter of
24 the Navajo Nation in McKinley county; and
- 25 7. five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to purchase and

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1 install meals equipment at the Bosque Farms senior meal site in
2 Bosque Farms in Valencia county.

3 SECTION 5. BERNALILLO COUNTY METROPOLITAN COURT PROJECT--
4 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
5 of this act, upon certification by the Bernalillo county
6 metropolitan court that the need exists for the issuance of the
7 bonds, thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) is appropriated to the
8 Bernalillo county metropolitan court to purchase and install a
9 video surveillance system and to plan, design, construct,
10 furnish and equip the fourth floor of the Bernalillo county
11 metropolitan courthouse in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

12 SECTION 6. BORDER AUTHORITY PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX
13 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act,
14 upon certification by the border authority that the need exists
15 for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are
16 appropriated to the border authority for the following
17 purposes:

18 1. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for
19 site improvements and to plan, design, construct, expand and
20 renovate a conference room at the border authority building in
21 Santa Teresa in Dona Ana county; and

22 2. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to
23 plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a visitor's center
24 at the border authority building in Santa Teresa in Dona Ana
25 county.

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1 SECTION 7. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX

2 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act,
3 upon certification by the facilities management division of the
4 general services department that the need exists for the
5 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
6 to the capital program fund for the following purposes:

7 1. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to
8 purchase and install furnishings, fixtures, equipment and
9 related infrastructure for a child wellness center in
10 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

11 2. two hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$280,000)
12 to plan, design, construct and renovate facilities, including
13 the purchase and installation of security improvements, at the
14 Camino Nuevo youth center at the youth diagnostic and
15 development center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

16 3. seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000)
17 to plan, design, purchase and install security and code
18 compliance improvements and to convert the existing swimming
19 pool into a multi-use facility at the youth diagnostic and
20 development center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

21 4. one hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$190,000)
22 to plan, design, construct, purchase and install new domestic
23 hot water boilers and to improve the Manzano and Sandia
24 cottages at the youth diagnostic and development center in
25 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

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1 5. one million five hundred thousand dollars
2 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and
3 equip the state police district office in Roswell in Chaves
4 county;

5 6. eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) to plan,
6 design, purchase and install a fire alarm system at the
7 reintegration center in Eagle Nest in Colfax county;

8 7. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for
9 site improvements and to plan, design, purchase and install
10 heating, ventilation and air conditioning units, electrical
11 system improvements, roofs and curbs at the J. Paul Taylor
12 center in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county;

13 8. five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to plan,
14 design, construct, furnish and equip phase 3 of the new Meadows
15 building and for infrastructure improvements at the New Mexico
16 behavioral health institute in Las Vegas in San Miguel county;

17 9. one million five hundred thousand dollars
18 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, demolish, construct, renovate,
19 improve, furnish and equip department of health facilities
20 statewide, including the purchase and installation of equipment
21 for the scientific laboratory division in Albuquerque in
22 Bernalillo county and for repairs to the therapeutic pool at
23 the Los Lunas campus in Valencia county;

24 10. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to
25 plan and design a new evidence and records facility and crime

1 laboratory, including expansion of the existing crime
 2 laboratory, at the department of public safety headquarters in
 3 Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

4 11. seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) to plan,
 5 design, construct, renovate, repair, purchase, install, equip
 6 and make other infrastructure improvements, including security
 7 upgrades and the design and replacement of heating, ventilation
 8 and air conditioning systems, at correctional facilities
 9 statewide;

10 12. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to purchase
 11 easements and to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish the
 12 relocation of the Texico port of entry in Texico in Curry
 13 county;

14 13. four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to plan,
 15 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip facilities,
 16 including infrastructure upgrades, demolition and abatement, at
 17 state-owned facilities statewide; and

18 14. eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) to plan,
 19 design and construct improvements to the medical examination
 20 room at the Henry Perea building in Los Lunas in Valencia
 21 county.

22 **SECTION 8. CULTURAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--**

23 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
 24 of this act, upon certification by the cultural affairs
 25 department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,

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1 the following amounts are appropriated to the cultural affairs
2 department for the following purposes:

3 1. two hundred twenty-nine thousand dollars
4 (\$229,000) to plan, design, construct and install a memorial to
5 gun violence victims in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

6 2. six hundred thirty-nine thousand five hundred
7 dollars (\$639,500) to plan, design, construct, renovate,
8 furnish and equip the national Hispanic cultural center annex
9 and site, including parking lot improvements, in Albuquerque in
10 Bernalillo county;

11 3. two hundred seventy-seven thousand five hundred
12 dollars (\$277,500) to plan, design, construct, equip, improve
13 and renovate the facilities, exhibits and site at the New
14 Mexico museum of natural history and science in Albuquerque in
15 Bernalillo county;

16 4. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
17 design, construct, landscape and improve the Bosque Redondo
18 memorial at the Fort Sumner historic site in De Baca county;

19 5. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
20 design and construct improvements to the Taylor-Barela-
21 Reynolds-Mesilla historic site, including the purchase and
22 installation of security upgrades and a heating, ventilation
23 and air conditioning system, in Mesilla in Dona Ana county;

24 6. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
25 design, construct, renovate and preserve the post ruins at the

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1 Fort Selden historic site in Radium Springs in Dona Ana county;

2 7. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
3 (\$175,000) to plan, design and renovate the restrooms,
4 including accessibility improvements, at the New Mexico museum
5 of space history in Alamogordo in Otero county;

6 8. seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) to plan,
7 design and construct the ruins footprint at the Coronado
8 historic site in Sandoval county;

9 9. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
10 design, construct, renovate and improve the exhibits and
11 facility at the museum of Indian arts and culture in Santa Fe
12 in Santa Fe county;

13 10. one hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
14 (\$195,000) to plan, design, construct and renovate the
15 facilities and courtyard at the New Mexico museum of art,
16 including fire protection system improvements, information
17 technology and related equipment, furniture and infrastructure,
18 in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

19 11. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to restore the
20 mural on the records center building in Santa Fe in Santa Fe
21 county;

22 12. four hundred seventeen thousand one hundred
23 seventy-five dollars (\$417,175) to plan, design, construct,
24 renovate, furnish, equip and improve the palace of the
25 governors state history museum facility, exhibits and site in

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1 Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

2 13. thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000) to purchase
3 equipment for preserving and digitizing films, photographs and
4 collections at the palace of the governors photo archives at
5 the New Mexico history museum in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

6 14. sixty-two thousand dollars (\$62,000) to
7 purchase and install furniture, equipment, fixtures and related
8 infrastructure and to plan, design and construct sidewalks at
9 the children's museum in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

10 15. one hundred eleven thousand dollars (\$111,000)
11 to plan, design, equip and construct improvements, including a
12 fire suppression system, a security system, drainage and
13 accessibility, for the center for contemporary arts in Santa Fe
14 in Santa Fe county;

15 16. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to plan,
16 design and construct improvements to the museum hill campus in
17 Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

18 17. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan,
19 design, construct, renovate, purchase, install, furnish, equip
20 and upgrade exhibits, facilities, sites and infrastructure at
21 museums, historic sites and cultural facilities statewide.

22 SECTION 9. CUMBRES AND TOLTEC SCENIC RAILROAD COMMISSION
23 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of
24 Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the Cumbres and
25 Toltec scenic railroad commission that the need exists for the

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1 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
2 to the Cumbres and Toltec scenic railroad commission for the
3 following purposes:

4 1. three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for
5 locomotive and boiler upgrades and rehabilitation to comply
6 with federal railroad administration standards for the Cumbres
7 and Toltec scenic railroad operating between New Mexico and
8 Colorado; and

9 2. three hundred fifteen thousand dollars
10 (\$315,000) for track rehabilitation and for related
11 infrastructure improvements to the Cumbres and Toltec scenic
12 railroad operating between New Mexico and Colorado.

13 SECTION 10. FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECTS--
14 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
15 of this act, upon certification by the first judicial district
16 court that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the
17 following amounts are appropriated to the first judicial
18 district court for the following purposes:

19 1. sixty-seven thousand two hundred dollars
20 (\$67,200) to purchase and install an integrated electronic
21 docket display system, including information technology and
22 related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for the first
23 judicial district court in Santa Fe, Los Alamos and Rio Arriba
24 counties; and

25 2. seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) to purchase

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1 and equip vehicles for the first judicial district court in
2 Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

3 SECTION 11. SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT--
4 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
5 of this act, upon certification by the second judicial district
6 court that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
7 eighty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$82,500) is
8 appropriated to the second judicial district court to purchase
9 and install video cameras in public and inmate transport
10 elevators at the second judicial district court in Albuquerque
11 in Bernalillo county.

12 SECTION 12. FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT--
13 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
14 of this act, upon certification by the fourth judicial district
15 court that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, eight
16 thousand dollars (\$8,000) is appropriated to the fourth
17 judicial district court to purchase furniture for the fourth
18 judicial district courthouse in Santa Rosa in Guadalupe county.

19 SECTION 13. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--
20 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
21 of this act, upon certification by the economic development
22 department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
23 the following amounts are appropriated to the economic
24 development department for the following purposes:

- 25 1. two hundred ten thousand dollars (\$210,000) to

1 plan, design, construct and renovate a former church building
 2 as a multipurpose events center for a cooperative economic
 3 development project between Innovate ABQ, incorporated, and the
 4 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

5 2. six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for economic
 6 development projects statewide pursuant to the Local Economic
 7 Development Act; and

8 3. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to
 9 plan, design and construct infrastructure improvements in
 10 mainstreet and local arts and cultural districts statewide.

11 SECTION 14. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--
 12 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
 13 of this act, upon certification by the public education
 14 department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
 15 the following amounts are appropriated to the public education
 16 department for the following purposes:

17 1. two hundred ten thousand dollars (\$210,000) to
 18 plan, design and construct a facility for the Albuquerque sign
 19 language academy in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

20 2. twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) for
 21 asbestos and lead paint abatement and to plan, design,
 22 construct and renovate the basement at Amy Biehl high school in
 23 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

24 3. thirty-seven thousand two hundred fifty dollars
 25 (\$37,250) to plan, design, construct and replace an elevator at

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1 Amy Biehl high school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

2 4. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to
3 purchase and install information technology, including related
4 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Amy Biehl high
5 school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

6 5. sixty thousand two hundred fifty dollars
7 (\$60,250) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install
8 landscaping, facilities, electrical and security improvements,
9 including the purchase and installation of storage, information
10 technology and related equipment, furniture and infrastructure,
11 at Cesar Chavez community school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
12 county;

13 6. twenty-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars
14 (\$26,250) to purchase and install information technology,
15 including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at
16 Cien Aguas international school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
17 county;

18 7. one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000)
19 to plan, design and construct phase 1 of a multipurpose sports
20 and performance center for Cottonwood classical preparatory
21 school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

22 8. eighty-seven thousand five hundred dollars
23 (\$87,500) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install
24 grounds, facilities, electrical and security improvements,
25 including the purchase and installation of storage, information

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1 technology and related equipment, furniture and infrastructure,
2 at Gilbert L. Sena charter high school in Albuquerque in
3 Bernalillo county;

4 9. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to plan,
5 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip the buildings
6 and grounds, including the purchase and installation of
7 fencing, information technology and related equipment,
8 furniture and infrastructure, at La Promesa early learning
9 center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

10 10. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to complete a
11 lease-to-purchase agreement for a building for the Media Arts
12 collaborative charter school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
13 county;

14 11. seventy-six thousand two hundred fifty dollars
15 (\$76,250) to purchase and install information technology,
16 including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at
17 Media Arts collaborative charter school in Albuquerque in
18 Bernalillo county;

19 12. forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) to
20 purchase and install information technology, including related
21 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Mission Achievement
22 and Success charter school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

23 13. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase
24 and install library resources for the Mission Achievement and
25 Success charter school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

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1 14. seventy-two thousand five hundred dollars
2 (\$72,500) to purchase and equip a bus for the Montessori
3 elementary school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

4 15. nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000) to purchase
5 and install information technology, including related
6 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Mountain Mahogany
7 community school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

8 16. twenty-one thousand two hundred fifty dollars
9 (\$21,250) to plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and
10 furnish the buildings and grounds at the student athlete
11 headquarters, including the purchase and installation of
12 equipment, information technology and related equipment,
13 furniture and infrastructure, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
14 county;

15 17. eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) to
16 acquire land for and to plan, design, construct, equip and

6 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

7 5. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
8 purchase and install equipment at the Craig Robertson soccer
9 complex at the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in
10 Bernalillo county;

11 6. three hundred forty-five thousand dollars
12 (\$345,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate and equip
13 lighting improvements at the football and soccer stadium at the
14 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

15 7. seventy thousand five hundred dollars (\$70,500)
16 to purchase and install advanced simulated patients for the
17 health professionals pipeline program for the university of New
18 Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

19 8. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan,
20 design, construct, equip and furnish the lesbian, gay,
21 bisexual, transgender and questioning resource center at the
22 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

23 9. one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars
24 (\$135,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and
25 equip the linguistics laboratory at the university of New

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1 Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

2 10. eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$88,000) to
3 purchase and install a dicer for the manufacturing engineering
4 program at the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in
5 Bernalillo county;

6 11. three hundred twenty thousand dollars
7 (\$320,000) to plan, design, restore, construct, equip, install
8 and furnish phase 3 improvements, including erosion and storm
9 water damage control and remediation measures, restoration of
10 historical structures and the purchase and installation of
11 signage and benches, to the university of New Mexico north golf
12 course urban open space area in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
13 county;

14 12. four hundred five thousand four hundred dollars
15 (\$405,400) to plan, design, construct, renovate and improve the
16 restroom facilities at Popejoy hall for the university of New
17 Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

18 13. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to purchase
19 and install equipment for the rugby team at the university of
20 New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

21 14. one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000)
22 to purchase and install safety lighting at the university of
23 New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

24 15. one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars
25 (\$135,000) to plan, design and construct improvements,

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1 including purchase and installation of furnishings and
 2 equipment, at the school of law at the university of New Mexico
 3 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

4 16. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to plan,
 5 design, construct, purchase and install improvements, including
 6 replacing the sound system, at University stadium at the
 7 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

8 17. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to plan,
 9 design, construct, renovate and equip lighting at the stadium
 10 for the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
 11 county; and

12 18. ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000) to plan,
 13 design, construct, renovate and repair the Harwood museum,
 14 including purchase and installation of equipment and fixtures,
 15 at the Taos branch campus of the university of New Mexico in
 16 Taos in Taos county.

17 **SECTION 32. WESTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY PROJECTS--**
 18 **SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
 19 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of
 20 western New Mexico university that the need exists for the
 21 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
 22 to the board of regents of western New Mexico university for
 23 the following purposes:

24 1. one hundred ninety-five thousand dollars
 25 (\$195,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install

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1 emergency telephone poles campuswide, including related
2 information technology, equipment, furniture and
3 infrastructure, at western New Mexico university in Silver City
4 in Grant county; and

5 2. eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) to
6 acquire property on west 12th street for western New Mexico
7 university in Silver City in Grant county.

8 SECTION 33. BORDER AUTHORITY PROJECT--APPROPRIATION FROM
9 THE FIRE PROTECTION GRANT FUND.--Notwithstanding the provisions
10 of the Fire Protection Fund Law to the contrary, one million
11 one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) is appropriated from
12 the fire protection grant fund for expenditure in fiscal years
13 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
14 this act, to acquire land for and to plan, design, construct,
15 equip and furnish a fire station at the Santa Teresa airport in
16 Dona Ana county.

17 SECTION 34. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECTS--
18 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GAME PROTECTION FUND.--The following
19 amounts are appropriated from the game protection fund to the
20 department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years
21 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
22 this act, for the following purposes:

23 1. seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) to acquire
24 land and to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip area
25 offices in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county and in Roswell in

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1 Chaves county;

2 2. five million five hundred thousand dollars
3 (\$5,500,000) to plan, design and construct improvements related
4 to safety compliance at state-game-commission-owned dams and
5 lakes and associated dams and spillways statewide; and

6 3. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan,
7 design, construct and improve new and existing shooting ranges
8 statewide.

9 **SECTION 35. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--**
10 **APPROPRIATION FROM THE BIG GAME ENHANCEMENT FUND OF THE GAME**
11 **PROTECTION FUND.--**Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is
12 appropriated from the big game enhancement account of the game
13 protection fund to the department of game and fish for
14 expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise
15 provided in Section 2 of this act, for fisheries renovation and
16 wildlife and riparian habitat restoration statewide.

17 **SECTION 36. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--**
18 **APPROPRIATION FROM THE SIKES ACT ACCOUNT OF THE GAME PROTECTION**
19 **FUND.--**One million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from
20 the Sikes Act account of the game protection fund to the
21 department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years
22 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
23 this act, for fisheries renovation and wildlife and riparian
24 habitat restoration statewide.

25 **SECTION 37. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--**

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1 APPROPRIATION FROM THE HABITAT MANAGEMENT FUND.--Five hundred
2 thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the habitat
3 management fund to the department of game and fish for
4 expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise
5 provided in Section 2 of this act, for fisheries renovation and
6 wildlife and riparian habitat restoration statewide.

7 SECTION 38. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--

8 APPROPRIATION FROM THE TRAIL SAFETY FUND.--Six hundred thousand
9 dollars (\$600,000) is appropriated from the trail safety fund
10 to the department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal
11 years 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise provided in Section 2
12 of this act, to construct off-highway vehicle recreation parks
13 statewide.

14 SECTION 39. MINERS' COLFAX MEDICAL CENTER PROJECTS--

15 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE MINERS' TRUST FUND.--The following
16 amounts are appropriated from the miners' trust fund to the
17 miners' Colfax medical center for expenditure in fiscal years
18 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
19 this act, for the following purposes:

20 1. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to
21 plan, design, construct, equip, upgrade and expand the
22 Alzheimer's unit courtyard at the miners' Colfax medical center
23 long-term care facility in Colfax county;

24 2. seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000)
25 to purchase, install and equip a cardiac monitoring system at

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1 the miners' Colfax medical center in Colfax county; and

2 3. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan,
3 design, construct, renovate, equip and furnish mechanical and
4 electrical system upgrades and improvements at the miners'
5 Colfax medical center long-term care facility in Colfax county.

6 **SECTION 40. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--**
7 **APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--**The
8 following amounts are appropriated from the public school
9 capital outlay fund, contingent upon approval by the public
10 school capital outlay council, to the public education
11 department for expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through 2020,
12 unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, for the
13 following purposes:

14 1. five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to plan,
15 design, renovate and construct public school pre-kindergarten
16 classrooms statewide; and

17 2. seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) to purchase
18 and equip school buses statewide.

19 **SECTION 41. STATE LAND OFFICE PROJECT--APPROPRIATION FROM**
20 **THE STATE LANDS MAINTENANCE FUND.--**One hundred fifty thousand
21 dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the state lands
22 maintenance fund to the state land office for expenditure in
23 fiscal years 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise provided in
24 Section 2 of this act, to plan, design, purchase and install
25 space saver storage systems at the state land office in Santa

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1 Fe in Santa Fe county.

2 SECTION 42. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS--
3 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE STATE ROAD FUND.--The following amounts
4 are appropriated from the state road fund to the department of
5 transportation for expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through
6 2020, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, for
7 the following purposes:

8 1. four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000)
9 to construct, equip and furnish a salt dome for the district 3
10 south urban patrol yard in Bernalillo county;

11 2. one million five hundred thousand dollars
12 (\$1,500,000) to construct, equip and furnish a patrol building
13 at the Gallina maintenance patrol yard in district 5 in Rio
14 Arriba county;

15 3. two hundred fifty-five thousand dollars
16 (\$255,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and
17 furnish restrooms at the general office complex to comply with
18 the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 in Santa Fe in
19 Santa Fe county;

20 4. two hundred ninety-one thousand dollars
21 (\$291,000) for electrical upgrades in the materials laboratory
22 at the general office complex in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;
23 and

24 5. two million four hundred thousand dollars
25 (\$2,400,000) to plan, design, construct and furnish district 2

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1 patrol facilities in Capitan, Carrizozo, Hondo and Fort Sumner
2 in Lincoln and De Baca counties.

3 **SECTION 43. ENERGY, MINERALS AND NATURAL RESOURCES**

4 DEPARTMENT PROJECT--APPROPRIATION FROM THE WATER PROJECT
5 FUND.--Notwithstanding the provisions of the Water Project
6 Finance Act to the contrary, two million five hundred thousand
7 dollars (\$2,500,000) is appropriated from the water project
8 fund to the energy, minerals and natural resources department
9 for expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through 2020, unless
10 otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, to plan, design
11 and construct watershed restoration improvements, including
12 forest thinning, statewide.

13 **SECTION 44. DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT PROJECT--**

14 APPROPRIATION FROM THE WATER PROJECT FUND.--Notwithstanding the
15 provisions of the Water Project Finance Act to the contrary,
16 one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) is
17 appropriated from the water project fund to the department of
18 environment for expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through 2020,
19 unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, to plan,
20 design and construct projects to improve surface water quality
21 and river habitat statewide.

22 **SECTION 45. HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

23 DEPARTMENT PROJECT--APPROPRIATION FROM THE WATER PROJECT
24 FUND.--Notwithstanding the provisions of the Water Project
25 Finance Act to the contrary, seven hundred fifty thousand

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1 dollars (\$750,000) is appropriated from the water project fund
2 to the homeland security and emergency management department
3 for expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through 2020, unless
4 otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, for natural hazard
5 mitigation community projects statewide and to match federal
6 emergency management agency funds.

7 **SECTION 46. OFFICE OF THE STATE ENGINEER PROJECT--**
8 **APPROPRIATION FROM THE WATER PROJECT FUND.--**Notwithstanding the
9 provisions of the Water Project Finance Act to the contrary,
10 two million dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated from the water
11 project fund to the office of the state engineer for
12 expenditure in fiscal years 2016 through 2020, unless otherwise
13 provided in Section 2 of this act, to plan, design and
14 construct an engineered levee in the San Acacia reach in
15 Socorro county.

16 **SECTION 47. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.--**If an
17 appropriation for a project authorized in this act is not
18 sufficient to complete all the purposes specified, the
19 appropriation may be expended for any portion of the purposes
20 specified in the appropriation. Expenditures shall not be made
21 for purposes other than those specified in the appropriation.

22 **SECTION 48. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.--**Pursuant to Section
23 13-4A-4 NMSA 1978 and where applicable, the appropriations
24 authorized in this act include one percent for the art in
25 public places fund.

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1 SECTION 49. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
2 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
