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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS; AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM CERTAIN FUNDS AND BALANCES; REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES; CLARIFYING CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS; ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF SEVERANCE TAX BOND PROCEEDS; ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--  
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts authorized for purposes specified in this act. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in this

1 act.

2 B. The agencies named in this act shall certify to  
3 the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds  
4 of the severance tax bonds appropriated in this section is  
5 needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section  
6 of this act. If an agency has not certified the need for  
7 severance tax bond proceeds for a particular project by the  
8 end of fiscal year 2020, the authorization for that project  
9 is void.

10 C. Before an agency may certify for the need of  
11 severance tax bond proceeds, the project must be developed  
12 sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

13 (1) incur within six months after the  
14 applicable bond proceeds are available for the project a  
15 substantial binding obligation to a third party to expend at  
16 least five percent of the bond proceeds for the project; and

17 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of  
18 the bond proceeds within three years after the applicable  
19 bond proceeds are available for the project.

20 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by  
21 law:

22 (1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds  
23 of severance tax bonds appropriated in this act for a project  
24 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund no later than  
25 the following dates:

1 (a) for a project for which severance  
2 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to match federal grants,  
3 six months after completion of the project;

4 (b) for a project for which severance  
5 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to purchase vehicles,  
6 including emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require  
7 special equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational  
8 technology; or other equipment or furniture that is not  
9 related to a more inclusive construction or renovation  
10 project, at the end of the fiscal year two years following  
11 the fiscal year in which the severance tax bond proceeds were  
12 made available for the purchase; and

13 (c) for any other project for which  
14 severance tax bonds were appropriated, within six months of  
15 completion of the project, but no later than the end of  
16 fiscal year 2022; and

17 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds  
18 of severance tax bonds appropriated for a project in this act  
19 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund three months  
20 after the latest reversion date specified for that type of  
21 project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

22 E. Except for appropriations to the capital  
23 program fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided  
24 pursuant to this act shall not be used to pay indirect  
25 project costs.

1           F. Except for a project that was originally funded  
2 using a tax-exempt loan or bond issue, a project involving  
3 repayment of debt previously incurred shall be funded through  
4 the issuance of taxable severance tax bonds with a term that  
5 does not extend beyond the fiscal year in which they are  
6 issued.

7           G. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
8 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
9 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
10 written obligations to third parties.

11           **SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--**  
12 **LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--**

13           A. Except as otherwise specifically provided by  
14 law:

15                   (1) the unexpended balance of an  
16 appropriation made in this act from the general fund or other  
17 state funds shall revert no later than the following dates:

18                           (a) for a project for which an  
19 appropriation was made to match federal grants, six months  
20 after completion of the project;

21                           (b) for a project for which an  
22 appropriation was made to purchase vehicles, including  
23 emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require special  
24 equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or  
25 other equipment or furniture that is not related to a more

1 inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of  
2 the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which  
3 the appropriation was made for the purchase; and

4 (c) for any other project for which an  
5 appropriation was made, within six months of completion of  
6 the project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2020;  
7 and

8 (2) all remaining balances from an  
9 appropriation made in this act for a project shall revert  
10 three months after the latest reversion date specified for  
11 that type of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

12 B. Except for appropriations to the capital  
13 program fund, money from appropriations made in this act  
14 shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

15 C. Except as provided in Subsection E of this  
16 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the  
17 general fund shall revert in the time frame set forth in  
18 Subsection A of this section to the capital projects fund.

19 D. Except as provided in Subsection E of this  
20 section, the balance of an appropriation made from other  
21 state funds shall revert in the time frame set forth in  
22 Subsection A of this section to the originating fund.

23 E. The balance of an appropriation made from the  
24 general fund or other state funds to the Indian affairs  
25 department or the aging and long-term services department for

1 a project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or  
2 pueblo shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection  
3 A of this section to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

4 F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
5 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
6 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
7 written obligations to third parties.

8 **SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS**

9 PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of  
10 Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the  
11 administrative office of the courts that the need exists for  
12 the issuance of the bonds, one million four hundred thousand  
13 dollars (\$1,400,000) is appropriated to the administrative  
14 office of the courts to purchase and install security systems  
15 and for technology upgrades related to security systems at  
16 magistrate courts and judicial district courts statewide.

17 **SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT**

18 ATTORNEYS PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the  
19 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by  
20 the administrative office of the district attorneys that the  
21 need exists for the issuance of the bonds, one hundred  
22 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) is appropriated to  
23 the administrative office of the district attorneys to  
24 purchase and install information technology and related  
25 system upgrades, including equipment, furniture,

1 infrastructure, storage, security appliances and security  
2 monitoring devices, for district attorney offices statewide.

3 SECTION 5. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT

4 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of  
5 Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the aging and  
6 long-term services department that the need exists for the  
7 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated  
8 to the aging and long-term services department for the  
9 following purposes:

10 1. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to  
11 purchase, equip and install an emergency generator at the  
12 senior center in Eagle Nest in Colfax county;

13 2. seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) to plan,  
14 design, construct, equip and furnish improvements, including  
15 accessible sidewalks, a parking lot, lighting, a covered  
16 entry and landscaping, for the senior center in Fort Sumner  
17 in De Baca county;

18 3. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to  
19 design, construct, purchase, equip and replace the heating,  
20 ventilation and air conditioning system and to purchase and  
21 install kitchen equipment at La Loma senior center in  
22 Guadalupe county;

23 4. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to  
24 design, construct, purchase, equip and replace the heating,  
25 ventilation and air conditioning system and to purchase and

1 install kitchen equipment in the Puerto de Luna senior center  
2 in Santa Rosa in Guadalupe county;

3 5. eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to plan,  
4 design and construct improvements and to purchase equipment  
5 for the Roy senior center in Roy in Harding county;

6 6. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to  
7 plan, design, purchase, construct and equip a building,  
8 including substructure, heating, ventilation and air  
9 conditioning, plumbing, electrical system, kitchen equipment  
10 and furniture, for a senior center in Hondo in Lincoln  
11 county;

12 ~~7. sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) to~~  
13 ~~acquire land and to plan, design, purchase and construct a~~  
14 ~~facility for a regional senior center in Gallup in McKinley~~  
15 ~~county;~~

16 8. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,  
17 design and construct improvements, including accessibility  
18 improvements, parking lot improvements, roofing and  
19 wastewater connections, to the Ramah senior center in  
20 McKinley county;

21 9. ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to plan,  
22 design and construct improvements, including roofing, parking  
23 lot and accessibility features, to the senior center in  
24 Thoreau in McKinley county;

25 10. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to



1 plan, design and construct a senior center in Wagon Mound in  
2 Mora county;

3 11. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to plan,  
4 design, construct, equip and renovate a senior center,  
5 including parking lot improvements, in Mescalero in Otero  
6 county;

7 12. fifty-nine thousand dollars (\$59,000) to  
8 purchase and install kitchen and meals equipment, including a  
9 commercial stove, a commercial kettle, a commercial mixer and  
10 a commercial dishwasher, in the Las Vegas senior center in  
11 Las Vegas in San Miguel county;

12 13. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to purchase  
13 and equip home meal delivery vehicles for Torrance county;

14 14. eighteen thousand four hundred dollars  
15 (\$18,400) to purchase, equip and install a replacement walk-  
16 in refrigerator/freezer at the Clayton senior citizens center  
17 in Clayton in Union county;

18 15. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to  
19 plan, design, construct and equip renovations and to improve  
20 code compliance at the Belen senior center in Belen in  
21 Valencia county;

22 16. ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to plan,  
23 design, purchase and install kitchen and meals equipment at  
24 the Belen senior center in Belen in Valencia county;

25 17. sixteen thousand five hundred dollars

1 (\$16,500) to purchase and install information technology,  
2 including related furniture, equipment and infrastructure, in  
3 the Meadowlake senior center in Valencia county; and

4 18. twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) to plan,  
5 design, purchase, construct and install a heating,  
6 ventilation and air conditioning system, including  
7 furnishings and equipment, in the Del Rio senior center in  
8 Rio Communities in Valencia county.

9 **SECTION 6. BERNALILLO COUNTY METROPOLITAN COURT**

10 **PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**Pursuant to the provisions of  
11 Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the Bernalillo  
12 county metropolitan court that the need exists for the  
13 issuance of the bonds, one million dollars (\$1,000,000) is  
14 appropriated to the Bernalillo county metropolitan court to  
15 plan, design, construct, furnish and equip courtrooms,  
16 judges' chambers, jury rooms and public and restricted access  
17 areas on the fourth floor of the Bernalillo county  
18 metropolitan court courthouse in Albuquerque in Bernalillo  
19 county.

20 **SECTION 7. BORDER AUTHORITY PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX**

21 **BONDS.--**Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act,  
22 upon certification by the border authority that the need  
23 exists for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred thousand  
24 dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to the border authority to  
25 plan, design and construct a flood control structure,

1 including land acquisition and environmental assessments, at  
2 the Columbus port of entry in Columbus in Luna county.

3 SECTION 8. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX  
4 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act,  
5 upon certification by the capital program fund that the need  
6 exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts  
7 are appropriated to the capital program fund for the  
8 following purposes:

9 1. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to  
10 plan, design, construct, furnish and equip renovations to the  
11 client cottages, including client hygiene areas and staff  
12 stations, at the youth diagnostic and development center in  
13 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

14 2. one million five hundred thousand dollars  
15 (\$1,500,000) to purchase and install equipment and to plan,  
16 design, construct, renovate and furnish facilities and for  
17 infrastructure improvements, including roofs, heating,  
18 ventilation and air conditioning systems, lighting and  
19 interior service windows, at the Albert Amador building in  
20 Espanola in Rio Arriba county, the Harriet Sammons building  
21 in Farmington in San Juan county and the James Murray  
22 building in Hobbs in Lea county;

23 3. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to  
24 plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip  
25 commission for the blind facilities in Bernalillo and Otero

1 counties to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act  
2 of 1990;

3 4. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to purchase  
4 and install equipment and infrastructure improvements,  
5 including security system upgrades and servers, and to plan,  
6 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip facilities at  
7 the youth diagnostic and development center in Albuquerque in  
8 Bernalillo county, the Camino Nuevo youth center in  
9 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county and the John Paul Taylor  
10 center in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county;

11 5. five million one hundred thousand dollars  
12 (\$5,100,000) to plan, design, construct, equip, renovate,  
13 upgrade and furnish a facility or to expand an existing  
14 state-owned site to house the department of health vital  
15 records and health statistics bureau in Santa Fe in Santa Fe  
16 county;

17 6. two hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$270,000)  
18 to plan, design, construct, replace, purchase and install  
19 improvements, including exterior sliding doors and fencing,  
20 at the New Mexico state veterans' home in Truth or  
21 Consequences in Sierra county;

22 7. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to  
23 plan, design, repair and upgrade the heating, ventilation and  
24 air conditioning system at the New Mexico state veterans'  
25 home in Truth or Consequences in Sierra county;

1           8. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to replace,  
2 repair, renovate, purchase and install emergency generators  
3 at correctional facilities statewide;

4           9. four million six hundred forty-five thousand  
5 dollars (\$4,645,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate,  
6 furnish, equip, repair, purchase and install equipment and  
7 improve infrastructure, including roofs, replacement of  
8 heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems and fire  
9 suppression, sewer and security systems upgrades, at  
10 correctional facilities statewide;

11           10. one million five hundred thousand dollars  
12 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish,  
13 equip, purchase and install equipment and for facility  
14 upgrades at department of health facilities statewide;

15           11. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan,  
16 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip state police  
17 district offices, including roadway and parking lot  
18 improvements, erosion control and the repair or  
19 replacement of heating, ventilation and air conditioning  
20 systems and surveillance systems, at district offices  
21 statewide;

22           12. one million five hundred thousand dollars  
23 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct, improve, renovate,  
24 remediate, furnish and equip facilities, including  
25 infrastructure upgrades, at state-owned facilities statewide;

1 and

2 13. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to  
3 plan, design, construct, renovate and furnish and to purchase  
4 and install equipment, including making other improvements to  
5 address building code compliance issues, at offices of the  
6 workforce solutions department statewide.

7 SECTION 9. CULTURAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--  
8 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1  
9 of this act, upon certification by the cultural affairs  
10 department that the need exists for the issuance of the  
11 bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the cultural  
12 affairs department for the following purposes:

13 1. two hundred eleven thousand three hundred  
14 dollars (\$211,300) to plan, design, construct, equip,  
15 renovate and improve the facilities, exhibits and site,  
16 including purchase and installation of furniture and  
17 equipment, at the New Mexico museum of natural history and  
18 science in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

19 ~~2. two hundred fifty-nine thousand five hundred~~  
20 ~~dollars (\$259,500) to purchase a robotic dinosaur and to~~

10 10. fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) to plan,  
11 design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and improve the  
12 site, facilities and exhibits, including historic ruins  
13 preservation, at the Jemez historic site in Sandoval county;

14 11. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to  
15 plan, design and construct improvements, including  
16 accessibility improvements, at the center for contemporary  
17 arts in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

18 12. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to  
19 plan, design, construct and equip renovations and repairs to  
20 an amphitheater, including shade structures, walkways,  
21 bancos, ramadas, horno ovens and a gate, at the museum of  
22 Indian arts and culture in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

23 13. two hundred three thousand three hundred  
24 dollars (\$203,300) to plan, design and construct renovations  
25 and other improvements to the New Mexico museum of art in

4 repair, renovate and make upgrades to the palace of the

14 and site preservation, at museums, monuments, historic sites  
15 and cultural facilities statewide.

16 **SECTION 10. CUMBRES AND TOLTEC SCENIC RAILROAD**

17 COMMISSION PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the  
18 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by  
19 the Cumbres and Toltec scenic railroad commission that the  
20 need exists for the issuance of the bonds, seven hundred  
21 fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) is appropriated to the  
22 Cumbres and Toltec scenic railroad commission for track  
23 rehabilitation and related infrastructure improvements,  
24 including locomotive and boiler upgrades to comply with  
25 federal railroad administration standards, and for

1 improvements to passenger cars for the Cumbres and Toltec  
2 scenic railroad operating between New Mexico and Colorado.

3 SECTION 11. DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE SECOND JUDICIAL  
4 DISTRICT PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the  
5 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by  
6 the district attorney of the second judicial district that  
7 the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, six hundred  
8 thousand dollars (\$600,000) is appropriated to the district  
9 attorney of the second judicial district to purchase and  
10 install security cameras, equipment and related technology  
11 for the office of the second judicial district attorney in  
12 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

13 SECTION 12. DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE FIFTH JUDICIAL  
14 DISTRICT PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the  
15 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by  
16 the district attorney of the fifth judicial district that the  
17 need exists for the issuance of the bonds, twenty-five  
18 thousand dollars (\$25,000) is appropriated to the district  
19 attorney of the fifth judicial district to furnish the  
20 offices of the fifth judicial district attorney in the county  
21 judicial complex in Lovington in Lea county.

22 ~~SECTION 13. FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECTS--~~  
23 ~~SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1~~

20 SECTION 15. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROJECT--  
21 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1  
22 of this act, upon certification by the economic development  
23 department that the need exists for the issuance of the  
24 bonds, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is  
25 appropriated to the economic development department to plan,

1 design and construct infrastructure improvements in

21 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 15-3B-17 NMSA 1978  
22 to the contrary, one hundred twenty-three thousand dollars

5 SECTION 56. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--

8 thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) is appropriated from the big

20 SECTION 57. ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION TRUST--CONTINGENT  
21 AUTHORIZATION--BUDGET INCREASE REQUEST FOR SCHOOL BUSES.--If,  
22 pursuant to the environmental mitigation trust agreement for  
23 state beneficiaries entered into pursuant to the partial  
24 consent decrees entered in In re: Volkswagen "Clean Diesel"  
25 Marketing, Sales Practices, and Products Liability

1 Litigation, MDL No. 2672 CRB (JSC) (Dkt. No. 2103-1), the  
2 trustee approves the expenditure of funds to allow the public  
3 education department to replace school-district-owned buses  
4 statewide that are used to transport students to and from  
5 school pursuant to the Public School Finance Act, the public  
6 education department is authorized to request budget  
7 increases for that purpose totaling eight million dollars  
8 (\$8,000,000) in fiscal years 2019 through 2022, if that  
9 amount is approved by the trustee, or any other amount that  
10 is authorized by the trustee for the same purpose.

11 **SECTION 58. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.--**If an  
12 appropriation for a project authorized in this act is not

16 made for purposes other than those specified in the

18 **SECTION 59. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.--**Pursuant to Section

22 **SECTION 60. EMERGENCY.--**It is necessary for the public  
23 peace, health and safety that this act take effect
