15	SECTION 1. Section 42-10-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1971,
16	Chapter 215, Section 6, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"42-10-9. HOMESTEAD EXEMPTIONEach person shall have
18	exempt a homestead in a dwelling house and land occupied by the
19	person or in a dwelling house occupied by the person although
20	the dwelling is on land owned by another, provided that the
21	dwelling is owned, leased or being purchased by the person
22	claiming the exemption. Such a person has a homestead of
23	[sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000)] <u>one hundred twenty thousand</u>
24	dollars (\$120,000) exempt from attachment, execution or
25	foreclosure by a judgment creditor and from any proceeding of

2	executors or administrators in probate. If the homestead is
