14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted
16	to read:
17	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] HAZINGPENALTY
18	A. Hazing consists of a person who is a student of
19	a public or private post-secondary educational institution
20	willfully taking an action or creating a situation that
21	recklessly or intentionally endangers the mental or physical
22	health of another current or prospective student of the
23	educational institution when the person takes that action or
24	creates that situation for the purpose of the current or
25	prospective student's induction, initiation or admission into

or maintenance of membership in a student organization, student body or private athletic club, regardless of whether the organization, body or club is officially recognized, sanctioned or authorized by an educational institution. Hazing does not include coaching, training, conditioning, physical education, customary athletic events or school-sanctioned events. Β. A person who commits hazing is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978." SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2019. - 2 -.212534.1
