AN ACT

RELATING TO MUNICIPALITIES; REQUIRING MUNICIPALITIES TO PRESERVE VIDEO RECORDINGS FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] PRESERVATION OF VIDEO RECORDINGS.--

A. A municipality that monitors or has the ability to monitor thirty-five or more cameras located in that municipality shall preserve all audio and video records from every camera for a minimum of one hundred eighty days in accordance with Section 14-16-12 NMSA 1978.

B. As used in this section, "cameras" include security footage, traffic cameras, dashboard cameras and other cameras used by the municipality, but does not include lapel
