RELATING TO LICENSED SOCIAL WORKERS; PROVIDING FOR DUTY

SPECIFICATIONS, ANNUAL EVALUATIONS AND COMPENSATION PARITY FOR

LICENSED SOCIAL WORKERS EMPLOYED BY EXECUTIVE AGENCIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 9 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] EXECUTIVE AGENCIES--LICENSED SOCIAL WORKER
COMPENSATION PARITY.--

- A. By July 1, 2023, each executive agency shall develop specifications for work quantity, quality and duties for licensed social worker positions.
- B. Starting July 1, 2023, each licensed social worker shall receive an annual job performance evaluation.
- C. Starting July 1, 2024, each licensed social .224095.1

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worker shall receive compensation based on work quantity, quality, duties and the job performance evaluation.

As used in this section: D.

- "compensation" means salary and benefits; and
- "licensed social worker" means a person (2) who:
- engages in the practice of social (a) work under appropriate supervision and meets the qualifications of a licensed bachelor of social work pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act:
- is licensed in the state to engage in clinical social work practice and meets the qualifications for a licensed clinical social worker pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act:
- is licensed in the state to engage (c) in practice other than clinical social work and meets the qualifications for a licensed independent social worker pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act; or
- engages in the practice of social work under appropriate supervision and meets the qualifications of a licensed master of social work pursuant to the Social Work Practice Act."

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
