16	SECTION 1. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] REQUIREMENTS FOR BOAT DOCKS
17	EXCEPTION
18	A. As used in this section:
19	(1) "boat dock" means a structure extending
20	from the shore into the water to permit the landing and mooring
21	of vessels and includes the anchoring system and any catwalks
22	or bridges that will attach to the dock itself;
23	(2) "boat ramp" means a driveway protruding
24	into the lake that allows boats to be launched from their
25	trailers into the lake;
