AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PROPERTY; REMOVING COUNTIES FROM THE  
DEFINITION OF A "LOCAL PUBLIC BODY" THAT NEEDS STATE BOARD OF  
FINANCE APPROVAL TO SELL PROPERTY PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 13,  
ARTICLE 6 NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 13-6-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1979,  
Chapter 195, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"13-6-4. DEFINITIONS.--As used in Chapter 13, Article 6  
NMSA 1978:

A. "local public body" means all political  
subdivisions, except counties, municipalities and school  
districts, of the state and their agencies, instrumentalities  
and institutions;

B. "state agency" means the state of New Mexico or  
any of its branches, agencies, departments, boards,  
instrumentalities or institutions other than state  
educational institutions;

C. "state educational institutions" means those  
institutions designated by Article 12, Section 11 of the  
constitution of New Mexico; and

D. "school districts" means those political  
subdivisions of the state established for the administration  
of public schools, segregated geographically for taxation and
