20	A. Criminal desecration of a dead human body
21	consists of the unlawful dismemberment, disfigurement,
22	mutilation or burning of a dead human body or any unlawful act
23	that causes a dead human body to be devoured or scattered. A
24	person who commits criminal desecration of a dead human body is
25	guilty of a fourth degree felony.

B. Criminal sexual contact with a dead human body consists of the unlawful and intentional touching of the clothed or unclothed intimate parts of a dead human body or intentionally causing a dead human body to touch the intimate parts of another person. A person who commits criminal sexual contact with a dead human body is guilty of a third degree felony.

8 Criminal sexual penetration of a dead human body C. 9 consists of the unlawful and intentional causing of a dead 10 human body to engage in sexual intercourse, cunnilingus, 11 fellatio or anal intercourse or the causing of penetration, to 12 any extent and with any object, of the genital or anal openings 13 of a dead human body, whether or not there is any emission. A 14 person who commits criminal sexual penetration of a dead human 15 body is guilty of a second degree felony."
