15	REQUIRING RULEMAKING; PROVIDING PENALTIES.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is
19	enacted to read:
20	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] FREIGHT TRAILERS, TRAILERS AND TRUCKS
21	UNDERCARRIAGESREQUIREMENTSRULEMAKING
22	A. Every freight trailer, trailer or truck shall
23	have an undercarriage with a ground clearance of sufficient
24	height to prevent a vehicle or bicycle from driving under it as
25	established by the division by rule.

of Paragraph (5) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed limit.

E. Upon a second conviction for operation without a
permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section
66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred
fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction,
the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500).

F. Upon a second conviction for transport of a reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."
