Each center of excellence provided for in 2 Β. Subsection A of this section shall foster excellence in the 3 4 noted field through: 5 (1) collaboration among leaders of the state's agencies, higher education institutions, business 6 sector, national laboratories and community organizations; 7 (2) the development by those leaders of 8 strategies to accomplish that aim; and 9 10 (3) the execution of those strategies. C.
