Section 31-18B-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003, 22 23 Chapter 384, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read: "31-18B-2. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Hate Crimes Act: 24 25 "age" means sixty years of age or older;

- B. "gender identity" means a person's selfperception, or perception of that person by another, of the
 person's identity as a male or female based upon the person's
 appearance, behavior or physical characteristics that are in
 accord or opposed to the person's physical anatomy, chromosomal
 sex or sex at birth:
- C. "disability" means that the person has a physical or mental disability that substantially limits one or more of that person's functions, such as caring for oneself, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning and working;
- D. "motivated by hate" means the commission of a crime with the intent to commit the crime because of the actual or perceived race; religion; color; national origin; ancestry; age; [handicapped status] disability; status as a law enforcement officer; status as a firefighter or an emergency medical technician when the person is on duty as a firefighter or an emergency medical technician; gender; sexual orientation; or gender identity of the victim, whether or not the offender's belief or perception was correct; and
- E. "sexual orientation" means heterosexuality, homosexuality or bisexuality, whether actual or perceived."
- **SECTION 3.** EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2017.
