AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS IN NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Five million three hundred thirty thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$5,330,250) is appropriated from the general fund to the aging and long-term services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2015 to fund the following services in the following amounts:

(1) five million thirty-eight thousand four hundred ninety-two dollars (\$5,038,492) to the four area agencies on aging for senior services, including adult daycare, case management, congregate meals, home-delivered meals, in-home services, transportation and senior center services;

1 (2) two hundred forty thousand seven hundred
2 fifty-eight dollars (\$240,758) for volunteer programs,
3 including foster grandparents, senior companions and retired
4 senior volunteers;

5 (3) forty-six thousand dollars (\$46,000) for
6 expansion of evidence-based Alzheimer's disease programs in
7 northern New Mexico; and

8 (4) five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for
9 assistance services provided to grandparents raising
10 grandchildren.

11 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
12 at the end of fiscal year 2015 shall revert to the general
13 fund.
