A. Analysis of legislation submitted by executive agencies to the legislative finance committee for development of fiscal impact reports and committee analysis of legislation made available to a committee shall be made publicly available on the legislature's website as soon as is practicable.

Amendments and substitute legislation proposed and made available to a committee shall be made publicly available on the legislature's website as soon as is practicable and shall be maintained on the legislature's website, whether adopted or not.".
