WHEREAS, March 14 is Albert Einstein's birthday; and

WHEREAS, pi day's first large-scale celebration was
twenty-five years ago at the exploratorium in San Francisco,
California; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, the United States house of
representatives acknowledged the designation of March 14 as pi
day, an unofficial holiday celebrating the mathematical
constant pi; and

WHEREAS, pi day is an educational, fun-filled celebration
of art, science and sharing food (pie); and
