16	WHEREAS, licensure requirements for behavioral health
17	professionals vary from state to state; and
18	WHEREAS, the United States department of health and human
19	services reported in 2019 that New Mexico continues to suffer
20	from a shortage of behavioral health providers; and
21	WHEREAS, this shortage could be addressed by removing
22	barriers to licensure for behavioral health professionals and
23	by allowing licensure reciprocity with other states; and
24	WHEREAS, standardizing New Mexico state licensure
25	procedures for behavioral health professionals could provide a

1 solution to the disparities in behavioral health care; and 2 WHEREAS, the regulation and licensing department has the 3 expertise necessary to evaluate and make recommendations for licensure requirements for behavioral health professionals; 4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE 5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the regulation and licensing 6 7 department, the human services department and the department of 8 health be requested to study and report and make 9 recommendations on licensure requirements for behavioral health professionals; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the licensing of behavioral 11 12 health professionals by the following boards be studied: the counseling and therapy practice board; Α. 13 the board of examiners for occupational therapy; 14 Β.

15 C. the New Mexico state board of psychologist16 examiners; and

D. the board of social work examiners; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as part of the study, the regulation and licensing department, the human services department and the department of health be requested to:

A. evaluate each license overseen by each of those boards;

B. conduct a comparative analysis of each state's initial and renewal licensure requirements for the behavioral health professions overseen by boards or commissions;
