AN ACT

RELATING TO CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING; ESTABLISHING
CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVES TO
THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS; CHANGING PROVISIONS OF THE ELECTION
CODE RELATING TO PRECINCTS; AMENDING, REPEALING AND ENACTING
SECTIONS OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 1-15-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,
Chapter 240, Section 365, as amended) is repealed and a new
Section 1-15-15 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"1-15-15. [NEW MATERIAL] UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE--
CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS ESTABLISHED.--New Mexico is divided
into three congressional districts to be known and designated
as congressional district one, congressional district two and
congressional district three."

11 SECTION 3. Section 1-15-16.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1991
12 (1st S.S.), Chapter 7, Section 2) is amended to read:

13 "1-15-16.1. PRECINCTS.--

14 A. Precinct designations and boundaries used in the
15 [~~1991~~] 2021 congressional redistricting are those precinct
16 designations and boundaries established pursuant to the
17 Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act and revised and approved
18 pursuant to that act by the secretary of state as of [~~August~~
19 ~~16, 1991~~] November 30, 2021.

20 B. The boards of county commissioners shall not
21 create any precinct that lies in more than one congressional
22 district, nor shall the boards of county commissioners divide
23 any precinct so that the divided parts of the precinct are
24 situated in two or more congressional districts. Votes cast in
25 an election to fill a vacancy in the office of United States

1 representative or any general, primary or other statewide
2 election from precincts created or divided in violation of this
3 subsection shall be invalid and shall not be counted or
4 canvassed."

5 SECTION 4. Section 1-15-17 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,
6 Chapter 240, Section 367, as amended) is amended to read:

7 "1-15-17. UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE--NOMINATION AND
8 ELECTION.--One representative in congress shall be nominated
9 and elected from each congressional district for voting
10 purposes. Ballots for representatives in congress shall
11 designate the office as congressional district [~~number~~] one,
12 congressional district [~~number~~] two and congressional district
13 [~~number~~] three. Only voters of each district shall be eligible
14 to vote for the respective candidates of the district."

15 SECTION 5. TEMPORARY PROVISION--COMPILATION
16 INSTRUCTIONS.--The compiler shall remove from the NMSA 1978 the
17 provisions of Section 1-15-15.2 NMSA 1978 (copy of
18 congressional districts established by Judgment and Final Order
19 in *Egolf v. Duran*, D-101-CV-2011-02942 (1st Dist. Ct., filed
20 January 25, 2012)).
