16	SECTION 1. Section 31-18B-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,

the person's identity as a male or female based upon the person's appearance, behavior or physical characteristics that are in accord or opposed to the person's physical anatomy, chromosomal sex or sex at birth;

- C. "disability" means that [the] a person has a physical or mental disability that substantially limits one or more of that person's functions, such as caring for oneself, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning and working;
- <u>D. "homelessness" means that a person lacks a</u>

 fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence or has a

 primary nighttime residence that is:
- (1) a place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings, including cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings or bus or train stations; or
- (2) a publicly or privately operated shelter designed to provide temporary living accommodations, including congregate shelters and transitional housing;
- [Đ-] <u>E.</u> "motivated by hate" means the commission of a crime with the intent to commit the crime because of the actual or perceived race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, age, [handicapped status] <u>disability</u>, homelessness, gender, sexual orientation or gender identity of the victim, whether or not the offender's belief or perception was correct; .190209.2

and

[E.] F. "sexual orientation" means heterosexuality, homosexuality or bisexuality [whether actual or perceived]."

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2013.
