If a caregiver adds a child to the caregiver's existing motor vehicle insurance policy, the amount paid to the 10 caregiver or approved purchaser shall not exceed the increase 11 in cost attributable to the addition of the child to the 12 13 policy. Payment shall be made to eligible recipients in 14 C. the order of eligibility until available funds are exhausted. 15 If a child determined to be eligible reaches permanency status 16 or turns eighteen years of age, the program may pay for that 17 child to complete a driver education program and obtain a 18 driver's license for a maximum of six months after the date the 19 20 child reaches permanency status or six months after the date the child turns eighteen years of age." 21 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand 22 dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the 23 children, youth and families department for expenditure in
