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5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
6	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLEThis act may be cited as the
7	"Rural Air Service Enhancement Act".
8	SECTION 2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Rural Air
9	Service Enhancement Act:
10	A. "department" means the department of
11	transportation;
12	B. "director" means the director of the division;
13	C. "division" means the aviation division of the
14	department; and
15	D. "minimum revenue guarantee" means the amount of
16	money guaranteed by a municipality or county to be earned by
17	an airline providing scheduled air services to and from that
18	municipality or county, which is the difference between the
19	minimum flight charge revenue specified in the contract
20	between the municipality or county and the airline and the
21	amount of actual flight charge revenue received by the
22	airline that is less than that contractual amount.
23	SECTION 3. RURAL AIR SERVICE ENHANCEMENT GRANT
24	PROGRAM
25	A. The "rural air service enhancement grant

SB 133 Page l program" is created in the division to be administered by the director.

3 B. The director shall: 4 establish and publish deadlines and (1)5 guidelines for the submission of grant applications; 6 develop procedures for receipt, review (2) and approval of grant applications; 7 8 (3) receive, review and approve grant applications; 9 10 (4) monitor municipalities' and counties' use of grant money by reviewing annual reports submitted to 11 the director to ensure that grants are used consistently with 12 the terms of the grant awards; 13 (5) establish grant reporting requirements 14 15 that meet the general purpose of the Rural Air Service Enhancement Act; and 16 perform other duties as necessary to 17 (6) carry out the provisions of the Rural Air Service Enhancement 18 Act. 19 20 C. Each fiscal year, competitive grants for minimum revenue guarantees shall be awarded to applicants for 21 the sole purpose of funding rural air service enhancement 22

24 D. The director shall award grants to applicants25 through a competitive process and based upon the following SB 133

grants.

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1 criteria: 2 (1) the demand for service on the proposed 3 air routes; 4 (2) the economic impact on the municipality 5 or county of the proposed new air routes; and the feasibility of a common carrier 6 (3) licensed by the state servicing proposed new air routes. 7 Ε. Applicants shall meet the following minimum 8 criteria to be eligible for a grant: 9 municipalities or counties shall have a 10 (1) minimum population of twenty thousand persons residing within 11 a fifty-mile radius of the airport unless the municipality or 12 county has existing scheduled air service; 13 (2) aircraft to be used to service proposed 14 15 new air routes served by the rural air service enhancement grant program shall have a passenger capacity of not more 16 than nine persons; 17 routes to be served by the program shall (3) 18 be new air routes that were not served at the time the grant 19 20 was made; and minimum matching funds from a (4) 21 municipality or county shall be: 22 ten percent if the municipality or (a) 23 county has no existing scheduled air service at the time of 24 application; and 25

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1 fifty percent if the municipality (b) 2 or county has existing scheduled air service at the time of 3 application. 4 Individual grants awarded through the rural air F. 5 service enhancement grant program shall not: (1) exceed one million two hundred fifty 6 thousand dollars (\$1,250,000) per year for municipalities or 7 8 counties with existing scheduled air service; exceed one million seven hundred fifty 9 (2) 10 thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) per year for municipalities or counties not served by existing scheduled air service; or 11 be used for infrastructure improvement. 12 (3) G. Individual grants awarded through the rural air 13 service enhancement grant program shall cover a time frame of 14 15 at least two years. 16 н. No more than ten percent of the balance of the rural air service enhancement fund on July 1 of any year may 17 be used by the division for infrastructure improvements 18 associated with individual grants awarded through the rural 19 20 air service enhancement grant program. I. Funds received through individual grants 21 awarded through the rural air service enhancement grant 22 program shall be expended by the grantee municipality or 23 county only to airlines that have been selected through a 24 competitive process pursuant to the Procurement Code. 25

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1 SECTION 4. GRANT APPLICATIONS .-- A municipality or 2 county may submit an application to the director for a rural 3 air service enhancement grant. An applicant shall comply 4 with deadlines and guidelines published by the director. A 5 grant application shall include: a description of the facility that will serve 6 Α. the proposed new scheduled air service; 7 8 B. an estimate of the demand for the proposed new scheduled air service routes; 9 10 C. identification of the air common carrier that will service the proposed new scheduled air service routes 11 and the aircraft to be used on the new scheduled air service 12 13 routes; a description of existing scheduled air service D. 14 15 routes serving the applicant; a description and schedule of the proposed new 16 Ε. scheduled air service routes to serve the applicant; 17 a justification for the new proposed scheduled F. 18 air service routes; 19 20 G. the requested grant amount and the amount of any matching funds; and 21 the time frame for a commitment to subsidize Η. 22 the proposed new scheduled air service routes. 23 SECTION 5. RURAL AIR SERVICE ENHANCEMENT FUND--24 CREATED.--25 SB 133 Page 5

1 Α. The "rural air service enhancement fund" is 2 created in the state treasury. All appropriations, gifts, 3 devises, grants and donations received shall be deposited in 4 the fund. Money in the fund is appropriated to the division 5 for the purpose of carrying out the rural air service 6 enhancement grant program and related infrastructure improvements pursuant to the provisions of the Rural Air 7 8 Service Enhancement Act. Money in the fund shall not revert 9 at the end of a fiscal year. 10 Β. The fund shall be administered by the division. 11 Disbursements from the fund shall be made only upon warrant drawn by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant 12 to vouchers signed by the director or the director's designee 13 for the purpose of carrying out the rural air service 14 15 enhancement grant program and related infrastructure improvements pursuant to the provisions of the Rural Air 16 Service Enhancement Act. 17 SECTION 6.
