11 RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; PROHIBITING THE USE OF STATE
12 EQUALIZATION GUARANTEE DISTRIBUTIONS FOR OUTREACH ACTIVITIES
13 AND ROOM AND BOARD EXPENSES FOR STUDENTS AT THE NEW MEXICO
14 SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 **SECTION 1.** Section 22-15F-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2008,
18 Chapter 15, Section 1) is amended to read:

19 "22-15F-1. SHORT TITLE.--~~[This act]~~ Chapter 22, Article
20 15F NMSA 1978 may be cited as the "New Mexico School for the
21 Arts Act"."

22 **SECTION 2.** Section 22-15F-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2008,
23 Chapter 15, Section 8) is amended to read:

24 "22-15F-8. ROOM AND BOARD COSTS--OUTREACH ACTIVITIES--
25 [~~PRIVATE FUNDING REQUIRED~~] USE OF STATE EQUALIZATION GUARANTEE

1 DISTRIBUTIONS PROHIBITED.--The school [~~shall~~], either through a
2 foundation or other private or public funding sources, shall
3 obtain [~~gifts, grants and donations~~] funding to ensure that the
4 school has adequate revenue to pay for all expenses associated
5 with outreach activities provided for in Section [~~6 of the New~~
6 ~~Mexico School for the Arts Act~~] 22-15F-6 NMSA 1978 and for room
7 and board costs for those students who are not able to pay the
8 full cost of room and board as provided in Section [~~7 of that~~
9 ~~act~~] 22-15F-7 NMSA 1978. The school shall [~~separately~~] account
10 separately for the costs of outreach activities and room and
11 board and for the revenue received from private or public
12 sources to pay those costs. The school shall not use money
13 received from the state equalization guarantee distribution for
14 these purposes. Failure of the school to secure adequate
15 funding for these purposes shall be grounds for denial or
16 revocation of a charter."

17 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**--The effective date of the
18 provisions of this act is July 1, 2013.
