15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted
17	to read:
18	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] MAKING A THREAT OF A SCHOOL SHOOTING OR A
19	THREAT OF A SHOOTING IN A PLACE THAT IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC
20	A. It is unlawful for a person to make a threat of
21	a school shooting or a shooting in a place that is open to the
22	public.
23	B. Whoever commits making a threat of a school
24	shooting or a threat of a shooting in a place that is open to
25	the public is guilty of a fourth degree felony.

2	(1) "school" means:
3	(a) the buildings and grounds, including
4	playgrounds, playing fields and parking areas and any school
5	bus, of any elementary school, secondary school, junior high
6	school, high school, college or university; or
7	(b) any other buildings or grounds,
8	including playing fields and parking areas that are not school
9	property, in or on which school or school-related activities
10	are conducted for any elementary school, secondary school,
11	junior high school, high school, college or university; and
12	(2) "threat of a school shooting or a threat
13	of a shooting in a place that is open to the public" means a
14	threat to bring a firearm to a school or public place with the
15	intent to:
16	(a) place a person or group of persons
17	in fear of great bodily harm;
18	(b) prevent or interrupt the occupation
19	or use of a school building; or
20	(c) cause a response to the threat by an
21	official or volunteer agency organized to deal with
22	emergencies."
