11 RELATING TO NATURAL RESOURCES; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE OIL
12 AND GAS ACT TO LIMIT USE OF THE OIL AND GAS RECLAMATION FUND
13 FOR AGENCY SALARIES.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 70-2-37 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1977,
17 Chapter 237, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "70-2-37. OIL AND GAS RECLAMATION FUND CREATED--
19 DISPOSITION OF FUND.--There is created the "oil and gas
20 reclamation fund". In addition to other sources, money in the
21 fund may consist of donations. All funds in the oil and gas
22 reclamation fund are appropriated to the energy, minerals and
23 natural resources department for use by the oil conservation
24 division in carrying out the provisions of the Oil and Gas Act.
25 The primary purpose of the oil and gas reclamation fund is to

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1 pay for contract services for plugging, remediation and
2 associated restoration work. Any use of the oil and gas
3 reclamation fund for division employee salaries shall be
4 limited to the following percentages of the annual distribution
5 to the oil and gas reclamation fund in each fiscal year by the
6 tax imposed by Section 7-30-4 NMSA 1978:

7 A. in fiscal year 2021, use of the oil and gas
8 reclamation fund for division employee salaries shall not
9 exceed forty-five percent;

10 B. in fiscal year 2022, use of the oil and gas
11 reclamation fund for division employee salaries shall not
12 exceed thirty-five percent;

13 C. in fiscal year 2023, use of the oil and gas
14 reclamation fund for division employee salaries shall not
15 exceed twenty-five percent; and

16 D. in fiscal year 2024 and each fiscal year
17 thereafter, use of the oil and gas reclamation fund for
18 division employee salaries shall not exceed fifteen percent."
