RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL FINANCE; REPLACING THE CREDIT TAKEN
FOR IMPACT AID PAYMENTS TO CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND STATECHARTERED CHARTER SCHOOLS; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new Section 22-8-25.2 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"22-8-25.2. [NEW MATERIAL] IMPACT AID CREDITS--PORTION
RETURNED TO CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND STATE-CHARTERED
CHARTER SCHOOLS.--

A. Each year, the department shall calculate and distribute one hundred percent of the previous year's impact aid credit taken pursuant to Section 22-8-25 NMSA 1978 for each school district and state-chartered charter school for which the department has taken one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- The actual amount of the

expenditures improved or will improve student achievement."

impact aid the state took credit for in fiscal year 2020's state equalization guarantee distribution pursuant to Section 22-8-25 NMSA 1978 from school districts and state-chartered charter schools that had federal impact aid revenue over one million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for distribution to those school districts and state-chartered charter schools in fiscal year 2021 to provide impact aid credit replacement funding pursuant to Section 1 of this act.
