AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE; REQUIRING THE LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE TO REPORT ON THE EQUITY AND FAIRNESS OF TRIBAL CAPITAL OUTLAY CUTS COMPARED WITH NONTRIBAL CAPITAL OUTLAY CUTS ON THE BASIS OF A COUNTY'S POPULATION AND TOTAL LOST DOLLARS IN PROPOSED LEGISLATION REVERTING CERTAIN CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 2-5-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1957, Chapter 3, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"2-5-3. LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE--DUTIES.--The legislative finance committee shall:

A. direct the director of the legislative finance committee in [~~his~~] the director's work;

B. examine the laws governing the finances and

1 operation of departments, agencies and institutions of New  
2 Mexico and all of its political subdivisions, the effect of  
3 laws on the proper functioning of these governmental units and  
4 the policies and costs of governmental units as related to the

6 C. recommend changes in these laws if any are  
7 deemed desirable and draft and present to the legislature any  
8 legislation necessary;

9 D. prepare a comparison of tribal versus nontribal  
10 cuts or reversions to capital outlay projects or funds by  
11 county, including the dollar amounts of the cuts or reversions  
12 compared to total county population, and report on the equity  
13 of cuts or reversions to the senate finance committee in  
14 advance of its issuance of a committee report on a bill to  
15 revert or cut tribal capital outlay; and

16 [~~D.~~] E. make a full report of its findings and  
17 recommendations for the consideration of each successive  
18 legislature following its original establishment, the report  
19 and suggested legislation to be available to each member of the  
20 legislature on or before the first day of the regular session  
21 [~~thereof~~]."

22 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
23 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
